

Addendum #1 Question Response Bid# 20-040 Scoreboards

- 1. Why is Nevco being shown with an additional three digits? The image was to provide a representation of the style of scoreboard. Please follow the specs in the scope for bidding purposes. Additional features may be included as an addendum.
- 2. Are they wanting Electronic Team Names? (one is shown with/ one without) No
- Are the dimensions of the signage what the schools want or would they like for both of them to be the length of the scoreboard? The length of the signage should be the length of the scoreboard.
- 4. At both sites, are the new scoreboards being installed in the same location as the existing scoreboards? Yes
- At both sites, if relocating the new scoreboards, who is responsible for Line side for power (120/240v A/C) and communication cable to new scoreboard? Scoreboards will be located in same area as existing.
- 6. During installation, will there be access to each scoreboard via the running track including up to a concrete truck?
 No, however; large trucks such as concrete will be able to get close. There are weight restrictions for tracks to prevent damage to asphalt surface.
- 7. At either site, can existing structure be used? Yes
- Can dirt spoils remain at each scoreboard site, on campus or hauled off? Some spoils may stay at scoreboard site for settling purposes. Excess can remain on campus at designated spot on campus if necessary.
- PG 10 of bid illustrates two scoreboards, one with what looks like vinyl team names and the other with programmable team names. Images are examples. Please follow the scope of work for bidding purposes.
- 10. Are both scoreboards to have programmable team names? No, but can be added as an separate alternate price.
