- Does the County have FAA Determination of No Hazard for the new tower? If not, the old one? Are we expected to obtain a new FAA DNH before stating construction, if necessary?
  IRC will apply for an FAA Determination of No Hazard. Contractor will not be expected to obtain.
- 3. Does the County desire grounding of the new tower? If so, please provide specifications. The tower is to be grounded per applicable NEC codes.
- 4. We are to install the communications cables from the antennas to the ground. Do we just coil them up at the bottom of the tower, or are we running them somewhere?

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The contractor will coil cable at the bottom of the tower. DFS will be responsible for installation and testing while contractor is on site.

5. Are we expected to sweep test the communication lines?No. DFS will be responsible for installation and testing while contractor is on site.
