SECTION I GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Note: Throughout this document the terms Proposer, Contractor, Company, Vendor, Firm or Bidder are used interchangeably and refer to any organization submitting a response to any solicitation. Additionally, the terms quote, bid or proposal are also used interchangeably and refer to the submission in response to any solicitation. Hamilton County Department of Education, will be referenced as "HCS".

- Requirements for Submitting Bids Bids made on forms other than the Proposal Form will
 not be considered. No modifications or alterations to the bid documents may be made either
 by interlineation, supplements or deletions. Documents submitted with modifications of any
 kind will be ruled non-responsive and the vendor possibly removed or suspended from the bid
 vendor listing for a period of up to two (2) years. The signature of the person submitting the
 proposal shall be in longhand without erasure. Bidders must provide one (1) original and one
 (1) copy in one sealed envelope.
- 2. <u>Exceptions</u>: Bidders taking exceptions to any part or section of this invitation shall indicate such exceptions on the bid form. Failure to indicate any exception will be interpreted as the bidder's intent to comply with and/or supply the requirements as written in the bid document.
- 3. <u>Bid amendment</u>: If it becomes evident that an invitation must be amended, a formal written amendment will be issued to all known Bidders. If necessary, a new due date will be established.
- 4. <u>Bid delivery</u>: HCS requires that all bids be submitted and time/date-stamped by the date and before the time specified in the bid documents to be considered, regardless of method of delivery. The time clock in the Procurement Department shall be the official record of the time. HCS is not responsible for any technical difficulties of any vendor in the delivery of its bid. No late bids will be accepted, opened or returned.
- 5. <u>Bid forms</u>: Vendors must complete bid forms contained in the bid package. Failure to fully complete the bid forms may result in rejection of the bid.

All information shall be entered in ink or typed/computer generated. Mistakes may be crossed out and corrections inserted before submission of your bid. Corrections shall be initialed in ink by the person signing the bid. Corrections and/or modifications received after the closing time specified will not be accepted.

- 6. <u>Bid preparation</u>: Prospective bidders are solely responsible for their own expenses in BID preparation and subsequent negotiations with HCS, if any.
- 7. <u>Bid pricing</u>: Any bid, and its associated pricing, shall remain valid for at least ninety (90) days after the bid due date, unless otherwise indicated in the bid specifications. Unit price must be shown for all products or services. In case of error in extension, unit price will govern.
- 8. <u>Bid submission and transmission</u>: Bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bid Number/Name, the closing date and time, as well as your company name provided on the envelope. If your response envelope is enclosed in another envelope/package for delivery, the latter should also be clearly labeled with the same identifying information.
 - All bids are to be F.O.B. Hamilton County, TN. All responses to this invitation become the property of HCS. Bids/Proposals submitted via e-mail or facsimile machine are unacceptable.
- 9. <u>Rights of Owner</u> The Hamilton County Board of Education reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any part thereof, to waive technicalities and informalities, and to award a contract to other than the low bidder. The right is reserved to reduce or increase the quantity of any item; and to award contract by item number, or group of items. Price, quality, and suitability will be considered in awarding bids. Samples to be submitted by the bidder upon request.
- 10. Negotiation Hamilton County Department of Education may select a successful Proposer on the basis of initial offers received without discussions. Therefore, each Proposal shall contain the Proposer's best terms from a cost or price, experience and technical, and a service standpoint. Hamilton County Department of Education reserves the right to enter into negotiations with Proposers. If Hamilton County Department of Education and the selected Proposer cannot negotiate a successful agreement, Hamilton County Department of Education may terminate said negotiations and begin negotiations with the other Proposers. Hamilton County Department of Education retains the right to negotiate with multiple Proposers simultaneously. This process will continue until a Contract has been executed or all Proposers have been rejected. No Proposer shall have any rights against Hamilton County Department of Education arising from such negotiations.
- 11. <u>Clarification of Bid Document</u> Should a bidder find discrepancies in or omissions from the bid document or should he be in doubt as to its meaning, he shall at once request clarification of the Owner.
- 12. <u>Awarding of Contracts</u> Award will be made to the most responsive, responsible bidder(s) meeting specifications, who presents the product or service that is in the best interest of HCS. HCS reserves the right: (1) to award bids received on the basis of individual items, or groups of items, or on the entire list of items; (2) to reject any or all bids, or any part thereof; (3) to waive any informality in the bids; and (4) to accept the bid that is considered best value.
- 13. <u>Tax Exemption</u> Sales and excise taxes do not apply to the equipment purchased by a board of education. These taxes should not be included when submitting bid prices on the attached Proposal Form. The necessary exemption certificate properly executed is to be provided by the successful bidder for signature by a representative of the Owner.

- 14. <u>Meeting Specifications</u> By my written signature on this bid, I (we) agree and certify that all items included in the bid meet or exceed any and all specifications covering such items. I (we) further agree, if awarded a contract, to deliver merchandise/service which meets or exceeds the specifications. Failure to comply with this section will result in removal of your firm from our list of bidders for at least six (6) months. This penalty does not preclude action to enforce specific performance.
- 15. <u>Declaration/Statement by Bidder</u> The respondent hereby states that he, his company, or any of its employees, agents, officers or proposed sub-contractors have not violated or participated in a violation of, been convicted, or pled "nolo contendre" to any act involving an unlawful restraint of trade such as, but not limited to violations of the Sherman Act (15 U.S.C. § 1-2), the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act (18 U.S.C. 1961-1968), the Hobbs Act (18 U.S.C. §1961), the mail or wire fraud statutes (18 U.S.C. §1341,1343), the false statements statute (18 U.S.C. §1001), the Tennessee Anti-Trust Act (T.C.A. § 47-25-101) or similar state or federal law. Respondent further states that he, his company or any of its officers, agents, or employees have not been debarred by any governmental agency (Federal, state, or local).

In submitting this bid, you are certifying that you are aware of the requirements imposed by T.C.A. §49-5-413(d) to conduct criminal background checks through the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation and the Federal Bureau of Investigation on yourself and any of your employees who may come in direct contact with students or who may come on or about school property anytime students are present. You are further certifying that at no time will you ever permit any individual who has committed a sexual offense or who is a registered sex offender to come in direct contact with children or to come on or about school property while students are present.

- 16. <u>Drug-Free Workplace Program</u>- Note: Required for construction services, encouraged for others. Law prohibits state or local governments from contracting for construction services with any private entity having five or more employees who has not furnished a written affidavit by its principal officer at the time of the bid or contract stating that the contractor is in compliance with the provisions of this act. Other organizations are encouraged to ensure that their workplace is Drug-Free.
- 17. <u>Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964</u> No person shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.
- 18. <u>Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972</u> Prohibits discrimination based on gender in all programs or activities that receive Federal financial assistance. Title IX also includes same gender harassment as well as student-to-student harassment.
- 19. <u>Proposal Acceptance</u>- Bidders shall hold their price and/or discount firm and subject to acceptance by HCS for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of the bid opening, unless otherwise indicated in their bid.
- 20. **Qualifications of Bidders** A bidder may be required, before the award, to show to the complete satisfaction of HCS that it has the necessary facilities, ability, insurance, and financial resources to provide the service or goods specified.

- 21. Restrictive or Ambiguous Specifications— It is the responsibility of the prospective bidder to review the entire invitation to bid (ITB) or request for proposal (RFP) packet and to notify the Procurement Department if the specifications are formulated in a manner that would unnecessarily restrict competition. Any such protest or question regarding the specifications of bidding procedures must be received in the Procurement Department not less than seventy-two hours prior to the time set for bid opening. These requirements also apply to specifications that are perceived to be ambiguous.
- 22. <u>Samples</u>: Samples of articles, when required, shall be furnished free of cost of any sort to HCS and may be retained for future comparison. Samples which are not destroyed by testing or which are not retained for future comparison will be returned upon request <u>at bidder expense</u>.
- 23. <u>Tn Department Of Revenue Requirements</u>: Before the Contract resulting from this solicitation is signed, the apparent successful Proposer must be registered with the Department of Revenue for the collection of Tennessee sales and use tax. HCS shall not approve a contract unless the Proposer provides proof of such registration. The foregoing is a mandatory requirement of an award of a contract pursuant to this solicitation.
- 24. No Contact Policy- After the date and time established for receipt of bids by the HCS Procurement Department, any contact initiated by any bidder with any HCS representative, other than the Procurement Division representative listed herein, concerning this solicitation is prohibited. Any such unauthorized contact may cause the disqualification of the bidder from this procurement transaction.
- 25. **PRICING:** Vendors are to quote a firm fixed price or discount for the next twelve months. At renewal time, the vendor may request a price increase. Proof of price increase must be supplied to the HCS Procurement Department. HCS reserves the right to accept or reject the requested price increase. If the price increase is rejected, the vendor may:

Continue with existing prices;

Submit a revised request for price increase;

Or not accept the renewal offer.

If a price increase is approved by HCS, the approval notification will be done in writing and the vendor will be notified of the new price schedule. This documentation will become part of the bid file. No approvals will be authorized verbally. Any price increase shall not exceed the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all Urban Consumers. However, vendor must submit proof of price increase.

26. **QUANTITIES-** HCS does not guarantee any quantities of items/services to be purchased. We will buy these items/services on an as-needed basis.

27. TN COOPERATIVE PURCHASING: also known as piggybacking, HCDE reserves the right to extend the terms, conditions and prices of this contract to other institutions (such as State, Local and/or Public Agencies) who express an interest in participating in any contract that results from bids and/or proposals. Each of the piggyback institutions will issue their own purchasing documents for purchasing of the goods. Bidder agrees that HCDE shall bear no responsibility or liability for any agreements between Bidder and the other Institution(s) who desire to exercise this option

SECTION II OBLIGATIONS, RIGHTS AND REMEDIES

These terms and conditions shall be part of the Contract. HCS reserves the right to negotiate other terms and conditions it deems appropriate and necessary under the circumstances to protect the public's trust.

- 1. **ACCEPTANCE**: All terms and conditions in this contract are deemed to be accepted by the vendor and incorporated in the bid, except the provision(s) which are expressly excluded by the specifications.
- ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Vendors are cautioned that any statement made by any
 individual or employee of HCS that materially changes any portion of the bid document, either
 before or after the issuance of the bid documents, shall not be relied upon unless
 subsequently ratified by a formal written amendment to the bid document.
- ALTERATION OR AMENDMENTS: No alterations, amendment, changes, modifications or additions to any contract resulting from this bid shall be binding on HCS without the prior written approval of HCS.
- ASSIGNMENT: Contractors shall not assign or sub-contract this agreement, its obligations or rights hereunder to any party, company, partnership, incorporation or person without the prior written consent of HCS.
- 5. <u>CODE OF ETHICS</u>: All suppliers are expected to adhere to business ethics and professional behaviors as outlined in these documents.
- 6. <u>COMPLIANCE WITH ALL LAWS</u>: Companies submitting bids must agree to observe and comply with all federal, state, and local laws, statutes, ordinances, and regulations, including but not limited to Title VI of the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Equal Employment Opportunity Act and the regulations issued there under by the federal government, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and the regulations issued there under by the federal government, in any manner affecting the provision of goods and/or services, and all instructions, prohibitive orders issued, and shall obtain all necessary permits.
- 7. **CONTRACT TERMS**: The successful proposer(s) will be required to enter into a contract with HCS to satisfy the requirements of this Bid.

It is HCS's intent to enter into a one (1) year contract with the successful proposer(s). Thereafter, HCS may at its option, extend the term of the contract for two (2) additional one (1) year contract terms under the same terms and conditions.

In the event that HCS exercises such renewal rights, all terms, conditions and provisions of the original contract shall remain the same and apply during the renewal period with the possible exception of rate adjustments and minor scope additions and/or deletions which may be agreed upon.

Note that these are not automatic renewals. It will be the responsibility of both parties to notify the other party in writing no less than ninety (90) days before the expiration of the contract period if the contract is to be extended for each additional term.

- 8. <u>DECLARATIVE STATEMENT</u>: Any statement or word (e.g., must, shall, will) are declarative statements and the vendor must comply with the conditions. Failure to comply with any such statement may result in their bid being deemed non-responsive and disqualified.
- 9. <u>DEFAULT</u>: In case of default by the vendor, HCS may procure the articles or services from other sources and may deduct from any monies due, or that may thereafter become due to the vendor, the difference between the price named in the contract or purchase order and actual cost thereof to HCS. Prices paid by HCS shall be considered the prevailing market price at the time such purchase is made. Periods of performance may be extended if the facts as to the cause of delay justify such extension in the opinion of the Procurement Director.
- 10. <u>DELIVERY OF GOODS AND SERVICES</u> It is understood and agreed that this bid shall constitute an offer which, when approved by the School Board and accepted in writing by the Purchasing Department, will constitute a valid and binding contract between the undersigned and the Hamilton County Department of Education. Failure to supply needed material and/or services will result in removal of your firm from our list of bidders for at least six (6) months.
- 11. <u>DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS</u>: Time of delivery shall be stated as the number of calendar days following receipt of the order by the vendor to receipt of the goods or services by HCS. *Note: Time of delivery may be a consideration in the award.*
- 12. <u>DISCOUNTS FOR PROMPT PAYMENT</u>: Vendors may include an option for cash discounts off of their quoted price, with terms of payment to be a minimum of Net 15. If a discount for prompt payment is offered by the bidder, it must be shown in the bidder's response; however, discounts for prompt payment will not be considered in the evaluation of bids or proposals. If earned, HCS will take all discounts offered for prompt payment, provided correct and proper invoices, prepared in accordance with the terms of the purchase order or contract, are processed and payment is issued or post-marked to the successful bidder within the stipulated time frame.
- 13. <u>DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE PROGRAM FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES</u>: Law prohibits state or local governments from contracting for construction services with any private entity having five or more employees who has not furnished a written affidavit by its principal officer at the time of the bid or contract stating that the contractor is in compliance with the provisions of this act. Companies, other than construction services, are also encouraged to have and maintain drug-free workplace policies.
- 14. **GRANT FUNDED PURCHASES**: For purchases that are grant funded, the Grant Agreement may contain/require special terms and conditions. If there is a conflict between the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement and the General Terms and Conditions of the Bid or RFP, the Grant Agreement Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
- 15. <u>INDEMNIFICATIONS/HOLD HARMLESS</u>: The vendor shall hold HCS, its officers, agents, servants, and employees, harmless from liability of any nature or kind because of use of any copyrighted, or un-copyrighted composition, secret process, patented or unpatented invention, articles or appliances furnished or used under this bid, and agrees to defend, at his own expense, any and all actions brought against HCS or himself because of the unauthorized use of such articles.

16. INSURANCE:

- A. Contractor will purchase and have in force insurance coverage listed below. The policy will be amended to include as additional named insured: Hamilton County Department of Education.
- B. The contractor must provide current insurance policies at all times during this contract period. Proof of insurance is required prior to contractor beginning work.
- C. Workmen's compensation insurance must cover all employees of the contractor who are involved in performance of the contract.
- D. Coverage Amount
 - Comprehensive Automobile Liability Bodily Injury and Property Damage Combined Single Limit \$1,000,000
 - 2. Comprehensive General Liability Bodily Injury and Property Damage Combined Single Limit \$1,000,000
 - 3. Workmen's Comprehensive Employer's Liability \$500,000
 - 4. Excess Liability for all Insurance Risks \$5,000,000
 - 5. Fidelity/Honesty Bond for each and all employees \$30,000
- E. Appropriate certificate(s) of insurance will be submitted with proposals.
- 17. <u>INVOICES</u>: Will be returned for correction unless they contain the following information: Purchase Order Number; Item Numbers; Description of Item; Quantity; Unit Price; Extensions; and Total.
- 18. **NEW EQUIPMENT**: The vendor shall guarantee that the units submitted for this bid shall be new, and the latest and most improved model of current production, and shall be first quality as to workmanship and materials used in said units. All modifications shall be made at the factory. Demonstrators shall not be acceptable. *NOTE: When the bid is for services, this item does not apply.*
- 19. **NON-COLLUSION**: Vendors, by submitting a signed bid, certify that the accompanying bid is not the result of, or affected by, any unlawful act of collusion with any other person or company engaged in the same line of business or commerce, or any other fraudulent act punishable under Tennessee or federal law.
- 20. <u>NON-CONFLICT STATEMENT</u>: Vendors, by submitting a signed bid, agree that it has no public or private interest and shall not acquire directly or indirectly any interest that would conflict in any manner with the provision of its goods or performance of its services. Supplier warrants that no part of the total Contract amount provided herein shall be paid directly or indirectly to any officer or employee of HCS as wages, compensation, or gifts in exchange for acting as officer, agent, employee, subcontractor or consultant to the Contractor in connections with any goods provided or work contemplated or performed relative to the agreement.

- 21. NON-DISCRIMINATION STATEMENT: Supplier must agree that no person on the grounds of age, color, disability, gender, genetic information, national origin, political affiliation, race, religion, sexual orientation, or veteran's status shall be excluded from participation in, or be denied benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the performance of this agreement, or in the employment practices of Vendor. Supplier shall upon request show proof of such non-discrimination, and shall post in conspicuous places available to all employees and applicants notices of non-discrimination. Suppliers covenants that it complies with the Fair Wage and Hour Laws, the National Labor Relations Act, and other federal and statement employment laws as applicable. Supplier covenants that it does not engage in any illegal employment practices.
- 22. <u>PAYMENT METHOD</u>- HCS utilizes two (2) methods of placing orders for products. The first is the use of Purchase Orders. These Purchase Orders will be issued from HCS Procurement Division via the method selected by the vendor during registration. The Purchase Order will detail the quantity, specific items(s) and the contracted price for each item.

The second method is the use of the HCS Credit Card (MASTERCARD). Orders placed with the credit card will list the same information as the Purchase Order. Vendors will be given the card information and approval to process the transactions by the requesting department. Vendors must indicate in their bid response if the vendor will accept the HCS Credit Card (MASTERCARD) as a form of payment. Bidders are prohibited to charge HCS any type of merchant fee from their financial institution to accept this type of payment.

- 23. **PAYMENT TERMS**: HCS payment terms are Net 30 after receipt/inspection of merchandise and receipt of invoice unless otherwise stated in the contract documents.
- 24. <u>PUBLIC ACCESS TO PROCUREMENT INFORMATION</u>: Subject to the requirements of the TN Open Records Act, information relating to the award of a particular contract shall be open to the public only after evaluation of that bid or proposal has been completed. All public records pertaining to procurement shall be open for inspection during normal business hours as scheduled in advance with the Procurement Department.
- 25. **PROTEST OF AWARD:** Any vendor who has submitted a timely bid or proposal in response to a solicitation may protest the recommendation of award for a contract by submitting such protest to HCS's Director of Procurement. Any protest must be submitted in writing and be in the possession of the Procurement Department before noon (ET) of the 2nd working day following the public recommendation of contract award.

FAILURE OF A VENDOR TO FOLLOW THE PROTEST REQUIREMENTS WITHIN THE TIME FRAMES PRESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION CONSTITUTES A WAIVER OF THE PROTEST AND ANY RESULTING CLAIMS.

26. **TAXES**: HCS is a tax-exempt organization. Sales, use or federal excise taxes should not be included in your bid.

- 27. TERMINATION FOR CAUSE: In the event of any breach of contract by the successful service provider(s), HCS may serve written notice to the service provider of its default, setting forth with specificity the nature of the default. If the defaulting party fails to cure its default within thirty (30) days after receipt of the notice of default, then HCS shall have the right to terminate the contract upon thirty (30) days written notice and pursue all other remedies available to HCS, either at law or in equity.
- 28. **TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE**: Contract may be terminated for convenience by either party by giving written notice to the other, at least sixty (60) days before the effective date of termination unless otherwise specified in the solicitation and/or contract documents. Said termination shall not be deemed a Breach of Contract.
- 29. <u>TERMINATION DUE TO NON-APPROPRIATION</u>: HCS shall not be obligated for the Contractor's performance hereunder or by any provision of this Contract during any of HCS's future fiscal years unless and until HCS appropriates funds for this Contract in HCS's Budget for each such future fiscal year.
- 30. **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**: In the event of a conflict between the specifications and these terms and conditions, the specifications will govern.
- 31. WARRANTIES: Vendor warrants to HCS that all items delivered and all services rendered shall conform to the specifications, drawings, bid and/or other descriptions furnished and/or incorporated by reference, and will be fit for the particular purpose purchased, of merchantable quality, good workmanship, and free from defects. Vendor extends to HCS all warranties allowed under the U.C.C. Vendor shall provide copies of warranties to the HCS. Return of merchandise not meeting warranties shall be at Vendors expense.
- 32. **WAIVING OF INFORMALITIES:** HCS reserves the right to waive minor informalities or technicalities when it is in the best interest of HCS.

The contractor of record must utilize only approved disinfectants from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention *List N: Products with Emerging Viral Pathogens and Human Coronavirus Claims for Use Against SARS-CoV-2. Examples of approved products include Quaternary Ammonium based products, Sodium Hypochlorite based products, Hydrogen Peroxide Based Products and Thymol Based Products.*

TIME OF SANITIZATION:

The contractor that provides this service will provide services starting 30 minutes prior to school starting and ending 30 minutes after school ends. This is an 8.5-hour day with a 30-minute lunch. The contractor must provide adequate labor coverage to ensure that all buildings are covered adequately. Surfaces should be disinfected at a minimum of 3 times per school day.

Specific criteria required for the contractor to qualify for this bid:

- 1. Contractor must provide rapid response disinfecting, sanitizing, and cleaning services utilizing COVID-19 cleaning protocols.
- 2. Contractor must provide Covid-19 Infection Control and Prevention Training to the staff by utilizing an OSHA approved educational training program for infection prevention. This training program must provide certified trainers who train facility managers and cleaning staff on the following:
 - a. Proper protocols for cleaning and disinfecting
 - b. Proper use of personal protective equipment
 - c. Proper solutions to reduce the spread of COVID 19.

The successful bidder must possess the following:

- 1. Certified industrial hygienist professional (CIH) disinfecting and cleaning protocols.
- 2. Infectious disease insurance coverage
- 3. IICRC Certified/COVID-19 Pathogen Compliant Technicians
- 4. Daily Cleaning Services

There will be three COVID-19 Cleaning Levels that must be addressed by the contractor of record:

Level 1: Fogging Only

Level 2: Touch Points

Level 3: Total Clean (fogging, wipe down, high touch points, and floors and walls)

Frequency of Cleaning Process:

The following outlines all areas that must be sanitized at a minimum of 3 times per day by use of spray, fog, mist sanitization, or wipe down disinfecting. NOTE: The vendor must use careful care to make sure that the surface is not damaged by the type of disinfectant used (example: Bleach based solutions fade fabrics):

- Door knobs on all buildings listed (all interior and all exterior)
- Light switches in all buildings (all interior)
- Toilet handles in all buildings
- Faucet handles in all buildings
- Chairs in all buildings
- Desks in all buildings
- Countertops in all buildings
- Door push plates in all buildings
- Tables in all buildings
- Toilets, urinals, soap dispensers and paper towel dispensers and partitions in all buildings

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND CONSIDERATIONS:

Staff must have adequate PPE and have reviewed SDS sheets for the use of the EPAregistered chemicals they are using in the disinfection of facilities. SDS sheets must be provided for all chemicals being used for the central office.

A two-step process will be used for all sanitization:

Step One is to **Clean**: remove all dirt and germs from Surfaces. If any surface is unclean, the contractor will clean that surface so it can be properly disinfected.

Step Two is to **Disinfect**: use EPA-registered chemicals to kill the germs on the Surfaces

All cleaning products must be left for the proper dwell-time in order for the chemical to be effective per factory recommendations. The use of electrostatic sprayers is encouraged.

NOTE: Contractor must be fully licensed, bonded, and insured and registered to work in the state of TN.
