

24-69 Door Access Controls Scope of Work

The Jones County School System has approximately 5,000 students, 800 employees, 8 school sites, and a Central Office, Technology, and Transportation Department that are standalone facilities. Jones County School District is seeking a qualified contractor to provide Access Controls for 100 selective exterior doors throughout the Jones County School District.

Vendors will provide an access control system with the following components/abilities:

- Wall-mounted ID badge readers
- Hardwired components
- First set of access control ID badges (All staff and high school students)
- Badge printer and software for printing replacement badges
- Ability to enact lockdown of all controlled doors at a site.
- Management via PC and mobile app
- Provide notification when doors are left open.
- Can interface with the bell schedule at the Jones County High School
- 3+ year warranty on all components
- Next day service
- Provide spare components to be kept on site (card readers and door strikes)
- Provide training after installation.
