Proposals shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check
upon a national or state bank in an amount not less than five per-
cent (5%) of the total maximum bid price payable without re-
course to the Owner, or a bid bond in the same amount from a re-
liable surety company, as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter
into a contract and execute performance and payment bonds
within ten (10) days after notice of award of Contract to him.
Such bid guarantee shall be made payable to CITY OF SHELBY-

The successful bidder must furnish a performance and payment
bond upon the form provided in the amount of one hundred per
cent (100%) of the contract price from an approved surety com-
pany holding a permit from the State of Tennessee to act as sure-
ty, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

All bidders shall have the applicable licenses to perform the
work as described in the plans and specifications within the
State of Tennessee. All workmen, operators and laborers on the
project shall be paid not less than the minimum hourly rates as
permitted by the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce
