BID FOR LUMP SUM CONTRACT

(hereinafter called "Bidder") to the CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, TENNESSEE

(hereinafter called "Owner")

Project: The Tub Grinding and Removal of grindings and/or brush-dirt mixture from City of Springfield property (**stockpiled there through March 27, 2019**) by the Engineer and having examined the specifications with the related documents and the site of the proposed work, and being familiar with all the conditions including the availability of materials and labor, hereby proposes to furnish all labor, materials and equipment to perform the work in accordance with the contract documents, within the time set forth therein, and at the Lump Sum price stated below with a **price per cubic yard for Additional Materials stockpiled**. These prices are to cover all expenses incurred in performing the work required under the contract documents, of which this proposal is a part. Unless otherwise indicated in the plans or specifications all work is to be performed and all quantities calculated by the specifications of the Tennessee Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, Latest Edition.

Bidder hereby agrees to commence work under this contract on or before a date to be specified in written "Notice to Proceed" of the Owner and to fully complete the project within **25 Working Days** from the date of the "Notice to Proceed", thereafter as stipulated in the specifications. **Bidder further agrees to pay as liquidated damages the sum \$ 250.00 for each Working day, thereafter as hereinafter provided.**

It is the policy of the City of Springfield not to discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, sex or disability in its hiring and employment practices, or in admission to, access to, or operation of its programs, services and activities and in federal or state sponsored programs, pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C. 2000d). With regard to all aspects of this contract, contractor certifies and warrants it will comply with this policy.

The City of Springfield is a Drug Free Workplace and requires all Bidders with "no less than five (5) employees receiving pay who contract with the City to provide construction services", to prepare and include with their bid documents an Affidavit certifying compliance with the Drug Free Workplace Program as stipulated in Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) 50-9-101 through 50-9-113. The statute forbids any local government from entering into any contract or awarding any contract for construction services with any employer who has not provided the affidavit of compliance.

The requirements of Public Acts of 2006, Chapter Number 878, of the State of Tennessee, addressing the use of illegal immigrants in the performance of any contract to supply goods or services to the City, shall be a material provision of this Contract, a breach of which shall be grounds for monetary and other penalties, up to and including termination of this Contract. The Contractor hereby attests, certifies, warrants, and assures that the Contractor shall not knowingly utilize the services of an illegal immigrant in the performance of this Contract and shall not knowingly utilize the services of any subcontractor who will utilize the services of an illegal immigrant in the performance of this Contract.

Successful bidder must provide the City of Springfield a Certificate of Insurance in the amount stipulated in the Specifications.

SPECIFICATIONS

Description:

The City of Springfield is requesting bids for the Wood Grinding and Disposal of product from J. Travis Price Park in Springfield. All ground material shall be removed and recycled.

General

- a. **All brush/wood shall be processed and removed from site, twenty (25) working days after commencing of grinding or Notice to Proceed from Owner, which ever comes first.**
- b. All bidders must inspect the brush disposal site before submitting a bid.
- c. Bidder shall provide all equipment and labor to move brush to grinder, feed tub grinder, operate tub grinder and load grinding onto trucks for removal.
- d. Work area is a public park and care must be taken to not damage areas outside work zone. Further hauling and grinding will not be permitted when weather conditions are such that damage may occur to the grassed area i.e. rutting, etc.
- e. Site is to be cleared of all brush and graded (leveled)
- f. Final grading shall be approved by the Public Works Dept

Equipment

- a. Grinder
- b. Must produce a minimum of 10 tons of wood product per hour.
- c. Excavator large enough to load logs into tub grinder

ADDITIONAL: Removal of Brush-dirt mixed area

1. Contractor shall be responsible to load and haul from site the dirt-brush mixed material located in rear (west) of the 100% brush site.
2. The entire site shall be graded (leveled) and all wood pieces removed
3. Final grading shall be approved by the Public Works Dept

Insurance

A Certificate of Liability Insurance shall be provided by the successful bidder with a minimum of 1,000,000 Liability insurance, plus Workman's Compensation.

Completion:

The City of Springfield is requesting the successful bidder to provide the City an approximate quantity of the tons or cubic yards of wood mulch removed from site.

IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT NOTICE

Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-12-106 requires the chief procurement officer to publish, using credible information freely available to the public, a list of persons it determines engage in investment activities in Iran, as described in § 12-12-105.
