REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The City of Shelbyville is requesting proposals for **OUTDOOR WATERSLIDE MAINTENANCE/REPAIR located at Shelbyville Recreation Center, 220 Tulip Tree Road, Shelbyville, TN.**

Proposals will be accepted by the City of Shelbyville Purchasing Office, 201 N. Spring St., Shelbyville, TN 37160 or may be mailed to P.O. Box 185, Shelbyville, TN 37162 **until 11:00 A.M., March 31, 2016.** Proposals should be submitted in sealed envelopes marked "**OUTDOOR WATERSLIDE MAINTENANCE/REPAIR - Shelbyville Recreation Center**". Any proposals received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of proposals will be returned to the bidder unopened.

Proposals will be opened at public meeting of council appointed bid committee on Thursday, March 31, 2016 at 11:00 A.M. at City Hall, 201 N. Spring Street. Award of the proposal will be made at the next scheduled City Council Meeting (April 14, 2016) at the Shelbyville City Hall Annex.

**MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS:**

Scope: To repair and perform any maintenance needed to the outdoor waterslide at Shelbyville Recreation Center.

**Work to be completed:**

- Maintenance to interior of flume to include repairs, buffing/waxing, & re-caulk of seams
- End cap repairs and gel coating

- Start tub repairs to eliminate soft spots and gel coating
- New gasket material at joint that is separated for winter storage
- Pressure wash exterior of flume to remove oxidation and debris
- Provide training to Recreation Center staff for proper maintenance of flume and future repairs to soft spots
- Specify in proposal the exact areas of repair
- SITE VISIT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED

**Site information:**

- Slide is an outdoor, 42" open flume
- Ride is 125' long with three turns
- Slide was installed by Professional Parks Inc (no longer existing) in 2003

**Successful bidder must provide proof of business license and liability insurance. Successful bidder must also provide proof of workers compensation insurance if required.**

Please note any variations to these requirements on submitted proposal.

Vendor selection will be based upon the best offer deemed acceptable by the City of Shelbyville's council appointed bid committee and City Council. Proposal to all or part of the RFP indicates a willingness to supply part or all of the proposal. The City of Shelbyville reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.

All bidders must comply with A.D.A. guidelines if required.

All bidders must be in compliance with Title VI, Civil Rights Act of 1964, which specifies that: No person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under a program or activity receiving federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation or the U.
