THE BRACKET ESTIMATE ON THIS PROJECT IS FROM \$600,000.00 TO \$700,000.00 THIS BRACKET RANGE IS SHOWN ONLY TO PROVIDE GENERAL FINANCIAL INFORMATION TO CONTRACTORS AND BONDING COMPANIES CONCERNING THE PROJECT'S COMPLEXITY AND SIZE. THIS BRACKET SHOULD NOT BE USED IN PREPARING A BID, NOR WILL THIS BRACKET HAVE ANY BEARING ON THE DECISION TO AWARD THE CONTRACT. THE PRINCIPAL ITEMS OF WORK ARE APPROXIMATELY AS FOLLOWS:

CLEARING AND GRUBBING, UNCLASSIFIED EXCAVATION, BORROW EXCAVATION, MOBILIZATION, CONCRETE SIDEWALK, 4" THICK, CONCRETE SIDEWALK, 6" THICK, SOLID SODDING, TRAFFIC CONTROLSCHEME, WATTLE, SILT FENCE, 15" SIDE DRAIN PIPE, 15" DUAL SIDE DRAIN PIPE, 18" DUAL SIDE DRAIN PIPE, STACKED BLOCK RETAINING WALL, SEED & MULCHING.

THE ENTIRE PROJECT SHALL BE COMPLETED IN **TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY (260)** CALENDAR DAYS. THE SR 161 PORTION OF THE PROJECT MUST BE COMPLETED AFTER LABOR DAY, DURING THE OFF SEASON, AS NO LANE CLOSURES WILL BE ALLOWED FOR THIS PORTION OF THE WORK BETWEEN MEMORIAL DAY AND LABOR DAY. A CASHIER'S CHECK (DRAWN ON AN ALABAMA BANK) OR BID BOND FOR 5% OF THE AMOUNT BID (MAXIMUM OF \$10,000.00) AND MADE PAYABLE TO THE CITY OF ORANGE BEACH MUST ACCOMPANY EACH BID AS EVIDENCE OF GOOD FAITH.

ALL BIDDERS BIDDING IN AMOUNTS EXCEEDING \$50,000 MUST BE LICENSED UNDER THE PROVISION OF TITLE 34, CHAPTER 8, CODE OF ALABAMA, 1975 AND MUST OBTAIN ALL NECESSARY LICENSES PRIOR TO THE BID OPENING. OUT OF STATE CORPORATIONS SHALL FURNISH A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY TO TRANACT BUSINESS IN ALABAMA. OUT OF STATE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES SHALL PROVIDE PROOF OF REGISTRATION TO TRANACT BUSINESS IN THIS STATE.

THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE REQUIRED TO PERFORM WORK AMOUNTING TO AT LEAST 30% OF THE TOTAL CONTRACT COST WITH HIS OWN ORGANIZATION.

PRIOR TO THE AWARD OF A COMPETITIVELY BID CONTRACT HAVE ONE OR MORE EMPLOYEES IN THE STATE OF ALABAMA, ALABAMA LAW REQUIRES THAT THE CONTRACTOR PROVIDE THE CITY PROOF OF ENROLLMENT IN E-VERIFY (see www.uscis.gov/everify).

THIS IS A FEDERALLY FUNDED PROJECT THROUGH ALDOT. THE PROPOSED WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN CONFORMITY WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CARRYING OUT THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ACT AND OTHER ACTS AMENDATORY, SUPPLEMENTARY, OR RELATIVE THERETO. THIS PROJECT IS SUBJECT TO THE CONTRACT WORK HOURS AND SAFETY STANDARDS ACT AND ITS IMPLEMENTING REGULATIONS. MBE/DBE PARTICIPATION IS ENCOURAGED; HOWEVER, NO SPECIFIC MBE/DBE GOALS HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR THIS PROJECT.
