**ITEM SPECIFICATIONS REQUESTED:**

**Open Front Industrial Bench/Spray Booth**

Overall Size Requirements-

4' 4" wide X 7' 2" tall X 2' long

Interior Working Size Requirements-

4' wide x 7' tall x 2' long

Must Include:

- (1) 18" diameter, ¾ HP, three phase, 208/230/40V, tube-axial fan operating at 2,000 SFCM @1/2" static pressure will provide exhaust
- (1) Manometer per exhaust chamber
- (1) ½" 120V solenoid valve (to be provided)
- A NEMA 1 enclosure with motor starter quoted as a separate line item.

Scope:

Air flows in through the open front of the booth, passes through the booth's working area and into the exhaust chamber located in the opposite end of the booth. Filtered air is drawn through the exhaust plenum and is discharged upward into the atmosphere through the exhaust stack. The booth is to be provide complete, with all necessary hardware to meet the applicable national requirements established by OSHA and the NFPA for paint booth construction.

**Construction Features:**

Panels:

Panels are to be fabricated from 18-gauge quality galvanized steel precision punched on 6" centers for maximum rigidity. Panels are to be fastened together with 5/16" bolts and are to be sealed with caulk following the assembly.

Filtration:

Exhaust Fan Unit:

A tube-axial type duct a specifically designed and constructed for use in paint spray booths and similar applications is to be provided for exhaust. A precision balanced, fabricated, aluminum non-sparking fan blade is to move the air through the fan. Bearings are to be mounted in rubber isolators for smooth operation. The motor, drive and bearings are to be isolated from the exhaust air stream. The bearings must be sized with a minimum average lifer per AFBMA, in excess of 200,000 hours when operating at the maximum RPM of the fan size.

Code Compliance:

All spray booth recommendations must be designed to meet or exceed the requirements and recommendations of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), Standard Number 33, as well as the Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA) CFR 29.1910.107 covering the operation and construction of spray booths.

Installation to be coordinated with Owner's Representative and Construction Manager.

Must provider Certificate of Liability Insurance for all installers.
