4. We would like to pose the question regarding page 9 of 15 of the RFP. In item 3 of the Submittal package item requirements, the paragraph states “The proposal shall be a lump-sum fee based on a current schedule of hourly rates.” To clarify, is the fee proposal to be included in the 5 page limit of the proposal? If so, how comprehensive would you like it to be as far as breaking out the items in the scope of services?  
[No. The one-page lump sum fee proposal must include all the services requested on page 4 of the RFP, including an allowance for ten asphalt cores and patching. Include a separate sheet with the hourly rate schedule. The five page limit is for a summary of the consultant’s qualifications, recent project information, references, and to identify the consulting engineer\(s\) performing the requested work.](#)
