Name of Project: Morrow City Hall Stormwater Infiltration Project

Separate sealed Bids for the construction of Morrow City Hall Stormwater Infiltration project will be received by the Clayton County Water Authority at 1600 Battle Creek Road, Morrow, Georgia until **3:00 p.m. local time, the 9th day of June 2016**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Any bids received after the specified time will not be considered. A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Clayton County Water Authority, 1600 Battle Creek Road, Morrow, Georgia 30260 on **Tuesday, May 17, 2016 at 3:00 p.m.**, local time, to discuss the Project. Attendance is encouraged but not required. Questions are due by **May 24, 2016 by 3:00 p.m.**, local time. A site visit will be conducted by the Owner immediately following the pre-bid meeting.

The Morrow City Hall Stormwater Infiltration project is located at Morrow City Hall, northwest of the intersection of Jonesboro Road and Morrow Road in Clayton County. The project will be constructed on a parcel owned by the City of Morrow located at 1500 Morrow Road. Construction and access easements necessary to complete the project have been obtained by the City of Morrow. The project Owner is the Clayton County Water Authority.

The goal of this project is to treat stormwater runoff and improve water quality, flood protection, and overall condition and health of East Jesters Creek and the watershed. The Morrow City Hall Stormwater Infiltration project includes a base bid of permeable pavers. Additive alternatives include one graded retention area and two swale areas. The project elements include: installation of safety fence and silt fence; clearing and grubbing; tree removal; removal of existing asphalt pavement; removal and installation of new curb and gutter; installation of permeable pavers and gravel reservoir; excavation and grading of two (2) swales and one (1) retention area; disposal of excess sediment; installation of two (2) concrete drop inlets and storm sewer pipe associated with the stormwater BMPs; installation of soil reinforcing matting; installation of rock riprap; and plantings and revegetation. The project also includes: survey; sediment and erosion controls; and geotechnical testing as required for project construction.

This project is partially funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under a Community Development Block Grant. Federal procurement process and reporting requirements will apply to this project.

The Bidding Documents, consisting of Advertisement of Bid, Instructions to Bidders, Bid Form, Bid Bond, Construction Contract, Performance Bond, Payment Bond, General and Supplementary conditions, Specifications, Drawings, and Addenda may be examined at the main offices at 1600 Battle Creek Road, Morrow, Georgia. **Bidding documents may be obtained electronically**

from Brown and Caldwell free of charge, or paper copies upon payment of \$60 for each set of full sized Drawings and Specifications. Return of the Documents is not required.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed Bid Form and accompanied by Bid security as prescribed in the Instructions to Bidders, payable to the Owner in an amount not less than 5 percent of the amount Bid. There is a base bid and three additive alternatives.

In order to perform public work, Bidder and its Subcontractors, prior to award of Contract, shall hold or obtain such licenses as required by State Statutes, and federal and local Laws and Regulations.
