The following questions came up and I have one change to make on the pricing information.

- 1) Is brush mowing once a year around the retention pond going to be included in the past?
  - a. Answer Yes, we need to do this every year. So, include it as a separate price.
- 2) Is the berm still to be mowed every other week?
  - a. Answer Yes, this includes the Right of Way along Rt. 34. Also please include this as a separate price.
- 3) Will you be enforcing the eradicating herbicide to control cattails?

Addendum 1-Landscaping Services Invitation to Bid

- a. Answer No, we have not done this. We do need an annual cut down of the cattails and cleaning of the inlets and outlets of the retention pond. This is usually done when the pond is frozen over in the middle of winter. Please include this as a separate price.
- 4) Is there any Maintenance inside the Solar field required.
  - a. Answer No.
- 5) Would watering of trees and lawns be time & material on separate billing? Or is it to be included? If so where is this to be added into?
  - a. Answer Omit this from the bid. We have never required this to be done. If we do require this work to be done by the vendor, we will negotiate it with the successful bidder at that time.
- 6) Does the contract require the bid to be done with Prevailing Wage?
  - a. Answer Our understanding is that maintenance items are not Prevailing Wage. Only new work is considered Prevailing Wage. However, please go to the State of Illinois website to determine what the State requires. Note: The State also requires the vendor to enter the Prevailing Wage directly into their site whenever work requiring Prevailing Wage is completed.

- 7) Do we include the Hardwood Mulch to be done annually or does Kendall County provide the mulch?

- a. Answer The vendor needs to include this as part of the bid. The amount can be put in under Attachment C – Fees & Reimbursements. Add it as part of the Tree, Shrub, Evergreen Maint column.
- b. Please note this is included in that column on your bids.
- 8) Please include the cost for Solar Pond Mowing on the attached sheet and include it in your bid with the rest of the response paperwork.
- 9) Please include a separate price for mowing the vacant lots at 108 W. Madison Street and 107 W. Ridge Street as separate prices 2x per month.
- 10) Bids remain due <u>February 17, 2022 by 10a.m.</u> at the Kendall County Facilities Management Office located at 804 W. John St., Suite B. Yorkville, IL 60560. Bids will be opened and publically read at that time.
