 conducting Phase I/Phase II ESAs, preparation of Quality Management Plans, Quality Assurance Project
 Plans, Work Plans Health and Safety Plans, and facilitating community involvement, and preparing
 Remedial/Corrective Action Plans
- Personnel with at least five (5) years of experience working with city or local governments, addressing economic redevelopment issues
- At least five (5) years of environmental consulting experience working in the State of Alabama
- Must have at least one professionally registered geologist and engineer in the State of Alabama

Applicants that do not comply with these minimum requirements and/or do not satisfactorily document in the SOQ that they meet the minimum requirements will not be considered. Selection of environmental consulting firms, in addition to the minimum requirements, will be based on the following rating criteria:

- Qualifications, Experience and capabilities
- Technical approach and ability to complete the stated RFQ requirements
- Capacity of firm to perform the work
- References and demonstrated capability to accomplish similar scope of services
