Statement of Purpose

The City of Goodlettsville is seeking bids for plaster repair at the Bowen House located in Moss Wright Park. The plaster repair to the Bowen House is needed in all interior rooms on the main level and two rooms upstairs.

Background Information

This original Bowen House is said to be the oldest standing brick home in Middle Tennessee and was constructed in 1787 by Captain William Bowen and was the birthplace of Tennessee Governor William Bowen Campbell. After being sold out of the family, the Bowen House went through a series of ownerships and was abandoned around 1960 due to its deplorable condition. In 1975 the Goodlettsville American Revolution Bicentennial Commission decided to restore the Bowen House. The Bowen-Campbell House Association was formed to carry out the project which was funded with federal and state grants along with private donations. During the restoration process, any materials salvageable were restored and reinstalled. Today, about 70% of the woodwork is original. Nearly all of the floorboards are original. All of the exterior doors were restored and one door still retains the original look. The house was opened for tours in 1980.

Minimum Bid Specifications

- Protect and cover flooring, windows, and doors
- Move furniture as needed
- Demo all loose and detonated plaster
- Patch and repair all damaged plaster
- Apply new smooth plaster finish coat ready for paint
- Minimum of three references

- Work must be completed by May 31, 2019.
