

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the Public Services Department Streets Division of the Town of Kernersville until **10:30 AM on March 2, 2023** in the Executive Conference Room (upstairs) of the Public Services Administration Building located at 509 Michael Street, Kernersville, NC 27284, and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read aloud, to furnish all materials and labor for the construction of Spring Resurfacing 2023 Paving Improvements for the Town of Kernersville.

Interested bidders must obtain a bid package in order to bid. Bid documents and this advertisement will be posted on the [Town of Kernersville](#) website.

Scope of Work: The proposed work includes five (5) different neighborhoods all located within the Town limits. Quantity estimates for each area are attached (Exhibit 1). The Town is specifically requesting that Department of Transportation (DOT) approved Turnbuckle style risers be used for the manholes that will need to be lifted (Exhibit 2). An overlay map showing the roads included in the project scope are highlighted in yellow in the attached map (Exhibit 3). The proposed work has an expected duration of 80 calendar days.

Pre-Bid Conference: Although attendance is not mandatory, it is encouraged and strongly recommended. At that time the various aspects of the project will be discussed. Bidders are encouraged to ask questions. An addendum outlining the items discussed at the Pre-Bid Conference will not be issued; however, any changes to or clarifications of the project documents that occur as a result of the Pre-Bid Conference will be issued as an addendum and become part of the contract.

A pre-bid conference is scheduled for 10:30 AM, Tuesday, February 21, 2023 at the Public Services Administration Building in the Executive Conference Room (upstairs), 509 Michael Street, Kernersville, NC 27284.

Consideration will be only given to Bidders who submit evidence that they are licensed contractors in the State of North Carolina, duly licensed accordingly for the appropriate section of work for which a Bid is submitted.

A 5% Bid Bond and 100% Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds are required for this project. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of thirty (30) days.

Minority businesses are encouraged to submit bids for this project. The appropriate forms are attached (Exhibit 4) and must be submitted with each bid to show good faith efforts to obtain Minority and Women Owned Business Enterprise participation.

The Town of Kernersville awards public contracts without regard to race, religion, color, creed, national origin, sex, age or handicapped condition as defined by North Carolina General Statutes, Section 168A-3. The Town of Kernersville reserves the right to reject any or all bids presented and to waive any informalities and irregularities.

If the Contract is to be awarded, Owner will give the Successful Bidder a Notice of Award within the number of days set forth in the Bid Form. No bidder may withdraw their bid within thirty (30) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

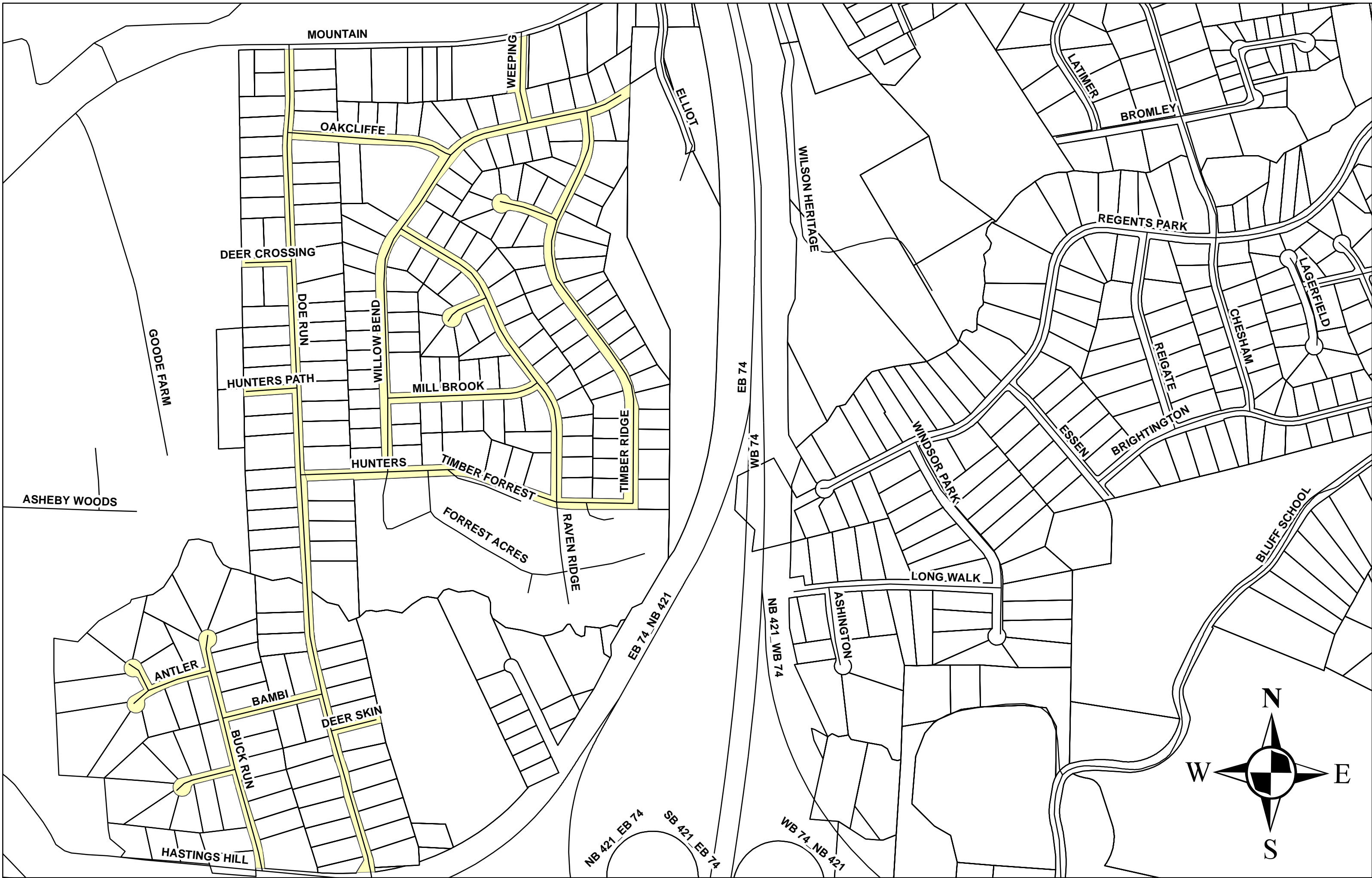

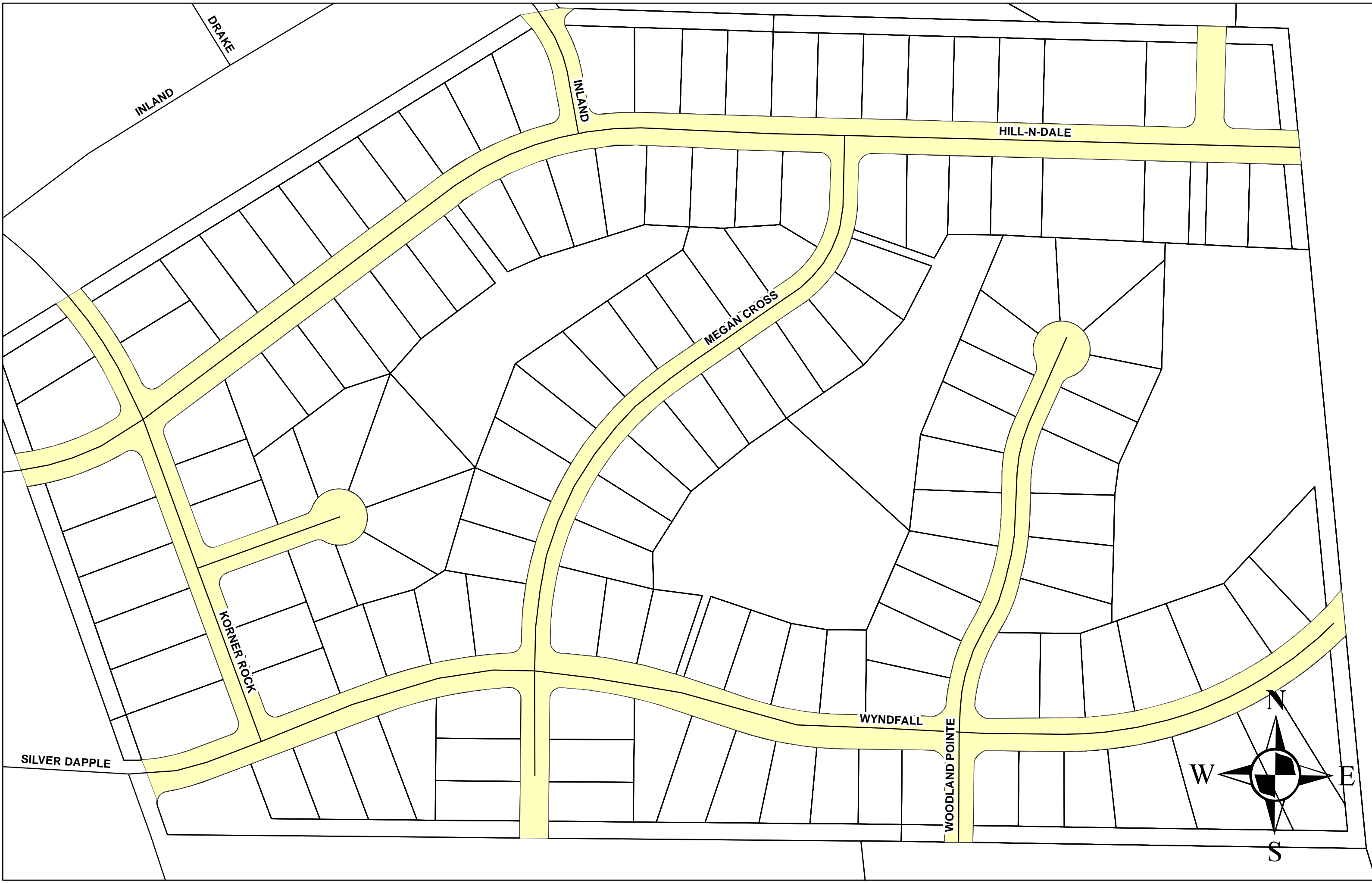

Bidders must earn at least 50 points from the good faith efforts listed for their bid to be considered responsive. (1 NC Administrative Code 30 I.0101)

- 1 – (10 pts)** Contacted minority businesses that reasonably could have been expected to submit a quote and that were known to the contractor, or available on State or local government-maintained lists, at least 10 days before the bid date and notified them of the nature and scope of the work to be performed.
- 2 – (10 pts)** Made the construction plans, specifications and requirements available for review by prospective minority businesses, or providing these documents to them at least 10 days before the bids are due.
- 3 – (15 pts)** Broken down or combined elements of work into economically feasible units to facilitate minority participation.
- 4 – (10 pts)** Worked with minority trade, community, or contractor organizations identified by the Office of Historically Underutilized Businesses and included in the bid documents that provide assistance in recruitment of minority businesses.
- 5 – (10 pts)** Attended prebid meetings scheduled by the public owner.
- 6 – (20 pts)** Provided assistance in getting required bonding or insurance or provided alternatives to bonding or insurance for subcontractors.
- 7 – (15 pts)** Negotiated in good faith with interested minority businesses and did not reject them as unqualified without sound reasons based on their capabilities. Any rejection of a minority business based on lack of qualification should have the reasons documented in writing.
- 8 – (25 pts)** Provided assistance to an otherwise qualified minority business in need of equipment, loan capital, lines of credit, or joint pay agreements to secure loans, supplies, or letters of credit, including waiving credit that is ordinarily required. Assisted minority businesses in obtaining the same unit pricing with the bidder's suppliers in order to help minority businesses in establishing credit.
- 9 – (20 pts)** Negotiated joint venture and partnership arrangements with minority businesses in order to increase opportunities for minority business participation on a public construction or repair project when possible.
- 10 - (20 pts)** Provided quick pay agreements and policies to enable minority contractors and suppliers to meet cash-flow demands.

The undersigned, if apparent low bidder, will enter into a formal agreement with the firms listed in the Identification of Minority Business Participation schedule conditional upon scope of contract to be executed with the Owner. Substitution of contractors must be in accordance with N.C.G.S. 143-128.2(d) Failure to abide by this statutory provision will constitute a breach of the contract.
