The Springfield Police Department is accepting sealed bids for the for the removal of the existing VCT tile in the basement and the grinding, polishing, staining and sealing with epoxy of the basement floor located at 802 Willow Street in Springfield, TN 37172.

Scope of Job-

The Springfield Police Department is currently seeking a contractor to remove the existing flooring (VCT tile) in the basement, down to the concrete and dispose of all of the refuse. The contractor will then grind, fill joints and imperfections, polish, stain and then seal the flooring with epoxy. The contractor will install new 4" baseboard throughout the basement, remove and reset toilets (4), create clean thresholds, adjust doors to ensure smooth openings and closings. Once the job is completed, the contractor will provide warranty paperwork.

Requirements-

- *Contractor must be bonded, licensed, and insured.
- *Provide 3 (three) commercial job references that can be inspected.
- *Responsible for the collection and removal of all refuse and debris.
- *Create and maintain a safe area for pedestrians to pass through the work area.
- *The flooring should be completed within 7 days.
