- 2. Fees for disposing of refuse at IREP @ Montgomery Waste Processing Facility, City of Montgomery Landfill and all other costs shall be taken into consideration when submitting bids. Any increase in fees for disposing of refuse will be negotiated with the parties involved.
- 3. Successful bidder shall be responsible for keeping all containers maintained in good repair, cleaned, sanitized and leak-proof.
- 4. Pick-ups which fall on Holidays will be picked up the following day.

It restricts our service area to the City of Montgomery and Montgomery County. Therefore, it is absolutely essential that the North Montgomery Sanitary Landfill is operated in accordance with the ADEM permit and regulations. This means that, upon other things, waste from outside the service area (e.g. Autauga, Elmore, Lowndes Counties) cannot be accepted for disposal. All loads are subject to inspection to determine the origins of the collected waste in the load. Loads found to contain waste materials from outside the service area will be rejected and the waste hauler will be required at their expense to pick up the waste and transport it off the landfill for subsequent disposal at another facility. 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ORDINANCE NO. 44-2008

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA, that Section 25-45. Landfill of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Montgomery be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 25-45. Landfill.

(a) Generally. The city operates a landfill for the purpose of disposing of garbage and trash by the city, commercial contractors, and by persons residing in the county. No toxic materials, hazardous or infectious waste will be accepted or disposed of at any landfill operated by the city. All persons entering city landfill property are required to follow instructions and abide by city landfill rules and regulations. Vehicles entering the landfill will be weighed before and after dumping at which time payment will be made to the landfill cashier immediately.

(b) Landfill service charges. Effective October 1, 2008, vehicles entering the city landfill to dump will be charged at a minimum rate of \$10.50 with an additional charge of \$2.10 per 100 pounds whenever the waste load exceeds 500 pounds. If the scales are not in operation, the charges will be \$14.00 per cubic yard for compacted waste and \$11.00 per cubic yard for uncompacted waste loads. Except for commercial waste hauling contractors, the maximum charge for landfill services will be \$221.00 per vehicle load. From time to time, at the discretion of the landfill management, earth excavation will be accepted at a minimum charge regardless of the load weight.

(c) Special handling charges. Effective October 1, 2008, in circumstances where additional labor, equipment and time are required to dispose of the waste or prepare a separate dumping area, a \$100.00 charge will be assessed; in addition to such \$10.50 minimum and \$2.10 per 100 pound weight fee or \$221.00 maximum per vehicle load when applicable. Items which typify qualification for incurring a special handling charge are unshredded tires, bank records, barrels/drums, bulk pesticide containers, bulk rubber, drugs/narcotics, dead animals, food waste, stockyard and slaughterhouse animal waste, state records, tires, and

baled paper.

Asbestos. Effective October 1, 2008, disposal fees for asbestos will be \$450.00 per cubic yard. Additionally, a separate \$240.00 gate fee will be

charged for each lead.

Tires. Effective October 1, 2008, in addition to the \$100.00 special handling fee contained in subsection (c) of this section, the disposal fee for unshredded tires will be \$84.00 per ton. The fee for shredded tires will be \$842.00 per ton, and the special handling fee will not be charged. For a fire to be accepted as shredded, it shall be cut, at a minimum, into four (quartered) pieces.

(f) Grease trap waste. Effective October 1, 2008, the fee to dispose grease trap waste will be \$1,000.00 per month for a maximum of 425 tons per month with an additional charge of \$2.00 per ton for each ton over 425 tons each month.

Construction and demolition debris. Effective October 1, 2008, disposal fees for inert or construction and demolition debris will be \$11.00 per cubic yard. Items which typify construction and demolition debris include: brush and land clearing debris such as los, stumps, branches, limbs, wood brush as well as tree remains from land clearing operations and constriction or demolition projects. Construction and demolition debris is further classified as material generally considered to be not water soluble and nonhazardous in nature including steel, scrap metal, brick, glass concrete, ceramics, asphalt roofing and paving material, pipe, wallboard, lumber, rocks, and soil. All items are not be contained with food waste materials or liquids.
