GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The City of Springfield reserves the right to waive any informally or irregularity that may occur if, in the judgment of the City, these occurrences do not adversely impact the overall bid or expressed intent of the bid process.
2. The City of Springfield reserves the right to reject any or all bids and award the contract to the vendor supplying the most for the monies invested.
3. Bids should be noted on the bid form attached with any exceptions or necessary clarifications attached as supplemental material. Product specifications or other materials should be attached to the submitted bid form properly marked as to the exact size and number of shells being submitted.
4. The City of Springfield shall have sole and final authority to determine which items meet specifications and which items are awarded the contract bid.
5. All materials shall be covered under standard manufacturer's warranty. Warranty information (if applicable) for listed products may be asked to be provided by bidder.
6. No bids will be accepted after bid closing time. Bids postmarked on the bid opening date but received after the specified time will be considered late and late bids will not be considered.
7. All bids must be signed. Failure of a bidder to sign the bid form removes that bid from consideration. A typed name will not be acceptable.
8. The material shall be delivered new, using current standards, and ready for operation.
9. It is the policy of the City of Springfield not to discriminate on the basis of race. Color, national origin, age, sex or disability in its hiring and employment practices, or in admission to, access to, or operation of its programs, services and activities. With regard to all aspects of this contract, contractor certifies and warrants it will comply with this policy.
10. All bids must include a signed Iran Divestment Form, otherwise bid will not be considered.

3. Bid includes set up, clean up and certified technician(s) shooting off the fireworks on the date agreed upon by City of Springfield Parks and Recreation Department.
4. Bidder will be responsible for all insurance certificates for the company as well as the program itself, permits from the state and/or local that are required for the event of this magnitude. Bidder must have a minimum of five million dollars \$5,000,000.00 in general liability insurance coverage.
5. Bidder must comply with USDOT regulations and have a legitimate DOT number for hauling explosives and conducting work within the United States.
6. Bidder must supply references from at least three (3) municipalities and at least one (1) non-government venue for which they have provided a program for a minimum of five (5) years.
7. A copy of the proposed contract must be included with the bid.

IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT NOTICE

Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-12-106 requires the chief procurement officer to publish, using credible information freely available to the public, a list of persons it determines engage in investment activities in Iran, as described in § 12-12-105.
