

## INVITATION TO BID

The City of Daytona Beach, Florida, will receive online bids for **Westside Regional WRF Battery Replacement UV-UPS System, Invitation to Bid No. 20432**, until **2:00 p.m., on May 7, 2020**. Bids received after said time will be rejected.

The City will only accept online Bids for this solicitation. The City's only authorized Bid Platform is Vendor Registry, accessible through the City's website [www.codb.us/841/Purchasing](http://www.codb.us/841/Purchasing) . No paper bids will be accepted.

**The work generally consists of** 1) The contractor shall furnish equipment, labor and materials to remove 240 Power First TC-12150C Absorbed Glass Matt, VRLA batteries, and to reinstall new batteries into 6 (six) cabinets. The contractor will ensure coordination and compatibility of equipment and repairs. 2) OWNER shall ensure that all support system are disabled prior to removal of the batteries. 3) Batteries shall be **FIAMM (FLX12-540) or EnerSys (HX12-540)** batteries. 4) The batteries shall be compatible with a Liebert 1000 KVA UPS System (Tag 1306306 – ID 90804).

The City of Daytona Beach, Florida, reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, or any portion of any bid, or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the City of Daytona Beach for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bid and investigating the qualifications of Bidders prior to awarding the contract. Vendors submitting bids to the City must comply with Article III of Chapter 30 of the Code of the City of Daytona Beach, Florida, "Minority and Women Owned Business Enterprises.
