Cost for Service

Bids are to include cost per weapon including all listed accessories, and shipping to the Goodlettsville Police Department, or FFL dealer if required by law. The Goodlettsville Police Department will be purchasing 42 of each listed item. The Goodlettsville Police Department will have numerous firearms for trade-in which will be deducted from the total cost of listed items. Each trade-in firearm will be traded AS-IS and the entire lot of trade-ins must be accepted. The value determined for the lot of trade-in weapons will be deducted from the entire cost of the listed items the Goodlettsville Police Department will purchase. If trade-in value exceeds the cost of the items purchased by the Goodlettsville Police Department, additional amount will be paid to the City of Goodlettsville.

Proposal Submittal Requirements

- An estimated delivery time frame after a purchase would be finalized

There will be a viewing date for the lot of firearms to be accepted for trade on July 28, 2016 from 0800-1200. This will be held in the auditorium of the Goodlettsville City Hall located at 105 South Main Street, Goodlettsville, TN 37072.

Submission Deadline

Proposals must be received by the Goodlettsville Police Department by no later than 4:00 pm CDT on the dates indicated below. Postmarks posting times in lieu of delivery will not be accepted. Please address bids and proposals to:

- Submittal due date: August 11, 2016
- Sealed bids will be opened at the Goodlettsville Police Department on August 12, 2016 at 1:00 pm CDT.

Successful bidder will be notified within 10 days of opening the bids, and other required approval.

Selection Process

A selection committee will review all submitted proposals and make final selection to award the contract.

The bid must conform to the specifications set and the City of Goodlettsville may reject any bid that deviates from the specifications as non-responsive.

The Goodlettsville Police Department reserves the right not to award the contract if it finds the proposals do not meet the needs of the department; if it determines the City of Goodlettsville can provide the equipment and/or services more effectively or efficiently; or if the funding available is deemed by the Department to be inadequate to support the project as submitted.

Proposals will be evaluated on the basis of the response to all provisions of this RFP. Since this solicitation is an RFP as opposed to a Bid, pricing alone will not constitute the entire selection criteria. The City of Goodlettsville may use some or all of the following criteria in its evaluation and comparison of proposals submitted. The criteria listed are not necessarily an all-inclusive list. The order in which they appear is not intended to indicate their relative importance:

- Product quality/performance
- Vendor's qualifications and experience
- Vendor's support/service
- Vendor's warranty/maintenance
- Total proposed price
- Compliance of the proposed items specifications to those requested by the City of Goodlettsville
- Ability of the vendor to provide all of the listed materials and services and to submit all required paperwork to the ATF.
- Ability to deliver the goods in a timely manner.

Prior to the delivery of the goods, the Goodlettsville Police Department, and the selected vendor will agree on contractual details. If an agreement is made, a purchase order will be issued to the selected vendor. The Goodlettsville Police Department is not responsible for any costs incurred by vendors in preparation of their proposal. Once submitted the proposal becomes property of the Goodlettsville Police Department. The Goodlettsville Police Department reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.
