SUBJECT: Addendum #1 to Invitation for Bids # 35976, Marsh Flow-Way C1 and C2 Maintenance Improvements

As a result of inquiries, the following clarifications/changes are provided for your information. Please make all appropriate changes to your bid documents. Note: changes are reflected with original language shown with strike-through and new language is underlined.

- Q1: Are the roads strong enough for dump trucks?
A1: The capped roads are adequate for dump trucks. Other non-capped roads will need maintenance to support dump trucks.
- Q2: What is the elevation of water in the lake?
A2: The water elevation in Lake Apopka is normally between 65-66 NAVD88. Currently the water elevation is 65.7 NAVD88.
- Q3: Will you be releasing a list of the pre-bid attendees?
A4: Pre-bid list of attendees is attached
- Q5: When the power point is released where will we find it?
A5: Powerpoint file is attached.
- Q6: Can the root balls stay?
A6: No, the willow root balls may support regrowth if left in place. Therefore the root balls should be excavated and buried within the cell with a minimum of 6 inches of cover. Please note this clarification supersedes the verbal answer provided at the pre-bid meeting on August 19, 2020.
