Specifications for Water Borne Paint

Traffic Operations

February 1, 2017

General Requirements:

The pigmented binder shall provide optimum adhesion for glass spheres when both binder and glass spheres are applied in the recommended quantities. The binder should be applied at a wet film thickness of 15 mils/.38 mm and the glass spheres shall be applied at the rate of eight (8) lbs. per gallon/.96 kg per liter of paint.

Detailed Requirements:

Formulation and Manufacture: The pigmented binder shall be formulated and processed specifically for service as a suitable binder for glass beads for use on traffic carrying pavements, such as concrete, brick and bituminous. It shall be well mixed or otherwise properly processed to meet the requirements herein as specified.

The pigment shall not settle excessively or cake in the container; shall not thicken or thin in storage so as to cause appreciable change in consistency. It shall not liver or curdle and shall be readily broken up with a paddle to a smooth uniform consistency.

The pigmented binder shall dry to an elastic adherent finish that will not turn dark in sunlight, nor show appreciable discoloration with age. It shall further permit ease and uniformity of application and covering properties.

Weight per Gallon:

The weight per gallon of pigmented binders shall be not less than 13.80 pounds per gallon/1.67 kg per liter for the **white** and not less than 13.00 pounds per gallon/1.64 kg per liter for the **yellow** material.

Flexibility:

When tested, the material shall not crack, flake or peel.

Directional Reflectance:

The daylight directional reflection of the pigmented binders (without glass spheres) shall be 88% for **white** and 50% for **yellow**.

Drying Time:

When applied at a wet film thickness of 15 mils/.38 mm with a bead application rate of eight (8) pounds per gallon, temperatures at 85% maximum and 50 degrees F/10 degrees C minimum respectively, the maximum drying time shall be 45 seconds with the paint temperature at the tip 120 – 140 degrees F. Temperatures at the heat exchanger should not exceed 140 degrees F/60 degrees C. Paint may dwell in exchanger for up to two (2) hours, but the recommendation is to either turn down the heat to 120 degrees F or turn off the heat to the exchanger and lines if the material will not be applied within one (1) hour.

The pH of both the **white** and **yellow** paints shall not be less than 9.6 when tested at 77 degrees F/25 degrees C.

Volatiles:

The volatile organic compounds (VOC) shall not exceed one (1) pound per gallon. Closed cup flash point shall not be less than 200 degrees F/93.9 degrees C.

Vehicle Solids:

The vehicle non-volatile shall be not less than 41.0% when the whole paint is ashed for one (1) hour at 877 degrees F/450 degrees C.

Shelf Life:

Material will remain in a usable condition up to twelve (12) months from date of manufacture when stored inside and protected from freezing.

Pigmented Binders:

The Pigmented binders shall, when tested according to ASTM D-869, have a minimum rating of 6. The viscosity shall not have changed by more than plus/minus 5 k.u.'s from the viscosity of the original sample. A one (1) pint sample will be conditioned for five (5) days at 130 degrees F/54.5 degrees C prior to evaluation.

Lead Quantity:

The dried films, both **white** and **yellow**, when tested in accordance with ASTM D-3335, shall not contain more than 0.06% lead

Containers:

Conventional epoxy phenolic lined steel drums.
