## THE PROJECT:

The Cherokee County Board of Commissioners Purchasing Department (County) is requesting competitive sealed Bids or Proposals in support for the construction of the <u>Batesville Road at</u> <u>Lower Birmingham Road Intersection Improvement, Project No. 62095 - Cherokee County</u>, as per current Georgia DOT Standards and Specifications as described herein.

There  $\square$  will be  $\boxtimes$  will not be a mandatory meeting to review the requirements.

The term of Agreement(s) resulting from this solicitation can be found in the Statement of Work.

All times in the solicitation are local times to Cherokee County Board of Commissioners, 1130 Bluffs Parkway, Canton, Georgia 30114.

The Bidder shall be responsible for performing at least 60 percent of the work in this contract. The Bidder shall not sub-contract, transfer, assign or otherwise dispose of the contract or any portion thereof, without the written consent of the County.

The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids/proposals, to waive technicalities and to make a selection and final award as deemed to be in the best interest of the County, including using any form of contract it deems most advantageous to the County. The County further reserves the right to reject the bid of any vendor who has previously failed to perform properly or complete on time contracts of a similar nature, or who upon investigation shows is not in a position to perform the contract. Incorporated herein by this reference are Cherokee County's Standard Solicitation Terms and Condition.

## THE EXPECTED PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE IS:

The base period of performance is broken down into two areas; Physical Delivery of Product(s) and Service Delivery. This is a function of the Statement of Work (SOW) and/or specification and reflects if there is physical item or items to be delivered and / or delivery of services. All interested parties are instructed to monitor the County's website on a regular basis throughout the solicitation period. The final date for posting of Addenda is per the Schedule, as may be amended.

## **STATEMENT OF WORK:**

The Cherokee County Roadway Capital Program Management Division is requesting bids for the following project:

Batesville Road at Lower Birmingham Road Intersection Improvement, Project No. 62095 - Cherokee County, as per current Georgia DOT Standards and Specifications.

Contract Time: 120 Calendar days, Proposal Guarantee: 5%

Bidders must be unconditionally qualified prospective bidders in accordance with Chapter 672-5 of the Rules of the Georgia Department of Transportation.

The work to be done consists of the furnishing of all material, labor and equipment for this project. All work performed for this project will be in accordance with Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications For Construction of Roads and Bridges, latest edition. Liquidated Damages assessed as per section 108.08 of the Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications.

A complete set of construction plans are included as a separate attachment.

#### **PROJECT SPECIFICS:**

The Contractor shall not perform work or move equipment or materials on the traveled way that visibly interferes with traffic flow on the mainline or local streets between the hours of 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday unless approved by the Engineer. Equipment or materials moved on or across the traveled way at other times shall be done in a manner as not to unduly interfere with traffic.

If night work is necessary to perform project work, a written request shall be submitted to Cherokee County and approved at least three days in advance. Working hours for night work are between 8:00 PM and 6:00 AM, Monday through Friday, unless approved by the Engineer.

It is the contractor's responsibility for coordination of utilities.

Construction signs need to be mounted.

Project limits are to be extended from Station 21+50 on Lower Birmingham Road, approximately 500 feet northeast to existing pavement joint at subdivision entrances.

The Bidder in compliance with your Notice to Contractors and all Bidding Documents for the **Batesville Road at Lower Birmingham Road Intersection Improvement, Project No. 62095** - Cherokee County, project, having examined the plans and specifications with related documents and the site of other proposed work, and being familiar with all of the conditions surrounding the construction of the proposed project, including the availability of materials and supplies to construct the project in accordance with the contract documents, within the time set forth herein, and at the prices stated below, proposes to enter into a Contract, on the form provided by Cherokee County, with Cherokee County to provide the necessary machinery, tools, apparatus, all materials and labor, and other means of construction necessary to complete the Work. The undersigned proposes to furnish and construct the items listed in the attached Schedule of Items for the unit prices stated.

Bidder agrees that the cost of any work performed, materials furnished, services provided or expenses incurred, which are not specifically delineated in the Contract Documents, but which are incidental to the scope, the intent, and completion of the Contract, shall be deemed to have been included in the price bid for the various items scheduled.

Bidder agrees to provide payment and performance bonds on the forms provided by Cherokee County and in conformance with applicable Georgia law. Any such bonds shall be subject to review and approval of the County Attorney.

Bidder, if successful, prior to commencement of the work shall execute a written oath as required by O.C.G.A. §§ 32-4-122 and 36-91-21(e).

Bidder further proposes and agrees hereby to promptly commence the Work with adequate force and equipment with seven (7) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed, or as may be specified by Special Provision, and to complete the Work as specified by the schedule in Special Provision Section 108-08 of the Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, latest edition.

The undersigned Bidder further agrees that in case of failure on his part to execute said contract and bonds, or provide satisfactory proof of carriage of the insurance required, within fourteen (14) calendar days after notification of award thereof, the Bid Bond or certified check accompanying his bid and the money payable hereon shall be forfeited to the County not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages because actual damages would be difficult or impossible to determine; otherwise, the check

or Bond accompanying this proposal shall be returned to the Bidder.

The Bidder declares that he understands that the quantities shown on the proposal are subject to adjustment by either increase or decrease, and that should the quantities of any of the items of work be increased, the undersigned proposes to do the additional work at the unit prices stated herein; and should the quantities be decreased, he also understands that payment will be made on actual quantities at the unit price bid and will make no claim for anticipated profits for any decrease in the quantities, and that actual quantities will be determined upon completion of work, at which time adjustment will be made to the Contract amount by the direct increase or decrease.
