There is a gate that will remain locked, but the combination to the lock will be: **2020**. This will allow temporary vendor access. The access point will be flagged or otherwise made clear when accessing the site. Please use due care when accessing and leaving the property to avoid damaging the grounds or surrounding areas.



The Rice Creek Conservation Area, which includes Nine Mile, is located on the left side of *State Road 100 West* if traveling from east to west, labeled below as Bolan Ramp Road.

Entering Rice Creek Conservation Area into your map application should return result below.



Below is an image of the extent of the Rice Creek Conservation Area, with access shown from both State Road 100 West and State Road 20.

Access from State Road 20 is available on the right side of the roadway when traveling east to west, and it intersects with Motes Island Road.
