

DEBRIS HAULING RFP No. PW2018-09 November 13, 2018 ADDENDUM #4

This addendum is being issued to clarify the following questions:

- 1. Price Schedule there is a blank row beneath each line item that has multiple items. In the quantity column the quantities are totaled. Are we to leave this row blank? For example the line item for hazardous leaning trees there are 6 line items for the various sizes of trees and then a final row totaling the quantities
 - A. You're going to provide the price, per piece, for each size, multiplied by the estimated total units for each size.
- 2. Price Schedule Transport and Disposal of HHW There are two separate units listed here Are we to price this \$/pound or \$/CY?
 - A. The price will be for Cubic Yards, as referenced in Addendum #3.
- 3. Price Schedule Waterway Debris Removal is this work to be performed via land based operations or marine based operations? Marine based work requires totally different equipment needs and scope reflecting a much higher rate. Will the City consider adding a line item for water-based operations and land-based operations?
 - A. It will all be land based operations.
- 4. The Second block of price items on the Price Schedule; "Eligible C&D Debris Removal" indicates that one of the concepts of operation the City would pursue is to have C&D debris hauled to a DDMS. This is the most prudent course of action in a major or catastrophic disaster. There are no price items for
 - a. managing a DDMS as a C&D DDMS and
 - b. the haul-out or removal of the C&D material to final disposal.

Would the City consider adding these two price items to the fee schedule to support the eventuality of hauling C&D debris to a DDMS and having a mechanism to cover costs of site management and haulout?

A. At this point we are not prepared to add these line items but will revisit at a later date.
