D-1 WARRANTY: The manufacturer warrants each automobile to be good material and workmanship and agrees to promptly replace any parts which fail due to defective material or workmanship when the vehicle is returned to the dealer where it was purchased for a period of 36 months or 50,000 miles, whichever comes first, from the date the vehicle is put in service by the City of Springfield. Replacement shall be free of charge excluding any deductibles standard to such warranties. If such failure renders the vehicle incapable of being driven, the vendor will be responsible for having the vehicle transported to his place of business. If such failure takes place outside the dealer's service area, the dealer will be responsible for reimbursing the nearest authorized dealer for services rendered under this warranty.

Tires are exempted from this warranty, but must be covered by the tires manufacturer's standard warranty and serviced by the local authorized dealer for the tire manufacturer

D-2 PARTS: The City of Springfield expects the manufacturer to have adequate stocks of replacement parts available to service city vehicles and to make delivery within a reasonable time of all normal replacement parts to their dealers who may service city vehicles. The city expects that warranty service and repair as well as non-warranty service and repairs will be handled without prejudice by local dealerships.

DECALS: No decals or markings of any type pertaining to advertisement shall be placed on vehicles delivered to the city, except trademarks or model designation normally installed by the manufacturer on the automobile

D-3 INSPECTIONS AND TESTS: Unless otherwise specified in the contract or purchase order, the supplier shall be responsible for the performance of all inspection and test requirements necessary to ensure compliance with requirements of this specification. This action does not preclude subsequent inspection and testing by the City of Springfield to further determine conformance with specification requirements of quality standards of workmanship, material and construction techniques.

E. PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY

E-1 PRE-DELIVERY SERVICING AND ADJUSTMENTS:

Prior to acceptance by the city, the dealer shall service and adjust each vehicle for operational use to include as a minimum the following:

1. Focusing of lights
 2. Tuning of Engine
 3. Adjustment of accessories
 4. Checking of electrical, braking, and suspension system
 5. Charging of battery
 6. Alignment of front end
 7. Inflation of tires
 8. Balancing of all wheels, including spare
 9. Complete lubrication of engine, chassis and operating mechanisms with recommended grades of lubricants for the ambient air temperature at the point of delivery.
 10. Servicing of cooling system with permanent type anti-freeze and summer coolant for minus 20 degrees F.
 11. Tennessee Safety Inspection sticker
 12. Warranty and owner's manual in glove compartment.

IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT

NOTICE

Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-12-106 requires the chief procurement officer to publish, using credible information freely available to the public, a list of persons it determines engage in investment activities in Iran, as described in § 12-12-105.
