Replacement shall be free of charge excluding any deductibles standard to such warranties. If such failure renders the vehicle incapable of being driven, the vendor will be responsible for having the vehicle transported to his place of business. If such failure takes place outside the dealer's service area, the dealer will be responsible for reimbursing the nearest authorized dealer for services rendered under this warranty. Tires are exempted from this warranty, but must be covered by the tires manufacturer's standard warranty and serviced by the local authorized dealer for the tire manufacturer D-2 PARTS: The City of Springfield expects the manufacturer to have adequate stocks of replacement parts available to service city vehicles and to make delivery within a reasonable time of all normal replacement parts to their dealers who may service city vehicles.
