Bidder further agrees to pay as Liquidated Damages (LD's) the sum of **\$0** for each consecutive calendar day that the Contractor shall be in default after the time stipulated in the contract for completing the work.

The specifications and addenda are complementary to each other. What is called for by one shall be as binding as if called for by all. If a conflict between any of the above is discovered by the Contractor, the problem shall be referred to the Owner as soon as possible for resolution. Should a conflict occur which is not resolved before bid time and/or is necessary to comply with mandatory requirements (i.e., codes, ordinances, etc.), it shall be the contractor's responsibility to price and bid the more expensive method.
