NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN — The Spartanburg Police Department is looking to solicit proposals for an integrated electronic portable message board system. The systems will serve multiple purposes. They contain an integrated system of a variable message board, a radar observation unit to be used for speed deterrent, and a traffic study software that allows us to quickly and accurately measure the amount of traffic as well as speed patterns of every vehicle on the roadway.

Proposals maybe held by the City of Spartanburg for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the opening of Proposals for the purpose of reviewing the Proposals and investigating the qualifications of prospective parties, prior to awarding of the Contract. The vendor that is awarded the proposal will be required to obtain a City of Spartanburg Business License.

Sealed proposals shall be submitted to Carl Wright, Procurement and Property Manager, on or before **Tuesday, September 1, 2020**, no later than 3 PM, City Hall, 145 West Broad Street, at which the time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Training Room, the same location.

Scope of work

The Spartanburg Police Department is looking to solicit bids for an integrated electronic portable message board system. The systems will serve multiple purposes. They contain an integrated system of a variable message board, a radar observation unit to be used for speed deterrent, and a traffic study software that allows us to quickly and accurately measure the amount of traffic as well as speed patterns of every vehicle on the roadway.

The message board feature will allow the department to post critical information and bulletins to the public. These could include messages about special events, safety hazards, road closures, and public health messages such as Covid testing sites or updates on the pandemic. The trailer would allow us to deploy these messages quickly and whenever they were needed.

They will also serve as a speed deterrent. These have integrated radar systems that display the speed of the approaching vehicles. These can be used in heavy traffic areas or areas that see a lot of citizen complaints. With our enforcement efforts down due to the pandemic, this is another deterrent to attempt to keep our roads safe.

They can also act as a traffic study software platform. While displaying the speeds of approaching vehicles, the trailers simultaneously record data from the vehicles. This gives us hard data to use to identify if a speeding problem exists, as well as identifying the times and days where the activity is the highest.

At a minimum, these systems should include:

- A single axle 4' x 8' pull behind trailer (all steel construction, powder coated with 4 leveling jacks to enhance stabilization)
- 2 communication ports (USB, Open)
- Solar Panel (140 watt) H
- Trailer tongue jack (removable tongue)
- 5 year warranty
- Rotating display board (360 degrees)
- 4 6 volt deep-cycle batteries or equivalent
- NTCIP compliant, 365 day calendar with on board computer and full sized key board
- Software which aids in the collection of traffic data and analysis
- Must be equipped with a speed awareness system (radar) and software to operate this system

Price should include any and all shipping cost, taxes and any other annual maintenance fees which will continue past the first year of purchase.

Attachment 3 EVALUATION / AWARD CRITERIA

Note: The proposals will be publicly opened. Only the names of the proposers and prices will be disclosed at the opening. Contents of the proposal shall not be disclosed during the evaluation or negotiation phases. Proposals shall be available for public inspection after award of the agreement. Proposals must be clearly marked "CONFIDENTIAL" for each part of the proposal that is considered to be proprietary information that could be exempt from disclosure under Section 30-4-40, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended ("South Carolina Freedom of Information Act"). If any part is designated as "CONFIDENTIAL", there must be attached to that part an explanation of how this information fits within one or more categories listed in Section 30-4-40. The City of Spartanburg reserves the right to determine whether this information should be exempt from disclosure.

City of Spartanburg shall evaluate each written proposal, determine whether oral discussions are necessary, then based on the content of the written proposal and any oral discussion, select the proposer best qualified for the project and which is most advantageous to City of Spartanburg, based on the following factors listed below.

The evaluation criteria will be:

- 1. Specifications Compliance 30%
- 2. Cost Requirements 45%
- 3. Service, support and Warranty Requirements 25%

Award Criteria:

City of Spartanburg shall evaluate each of the Proposals using the criteria set forth. The City reserves the right to request Proposers to appear for an additional presentation followed by a question and answer period, in order to further evaluate qualifications. The additional presentations, if any, will also be scored and combined with prior scoring to determine the successful Proposer. The City of Spartanburg is not obligated to accept the lowest cost proposal. The award of the contract, if awarded, will be made to the Proposer providing the most responsive, responsible proposal that provides the best overall value and service. The award, if awarded, will take into consideration several factors, including the soundness and flexibility of the proposal, functional capability, quality of performance, quality of service, ability to provide support, overall cost, the Proposer's experience and the Proposer's references. At the City's discretion, one or more firms may be engaged for this work.

Representatives of City of Spartanburg will evaluate individual proposals. Any proposer determined to be technically unqualified, or whose proposal is deemed unresponsive, will not be considered further.
