1.	Addendum 3 Question #2 states the interior of tank is to be sandblasted and coated. We need to
	know what the surface preparation and coating schedule is. The specifications only contain a
	paint system for the tank exterior.
	The interior of the tank shall be coated in the same manner as the exterior.
2.	Item #7 Ballast material. What is the approximate weight/tonnage needed?
	300 kips of material is required.

3.	Is coating touch up required on all the base bid repair items and if so, what is required? The concern is if the alternate tank painting item is awarded, the touch up material will be blasted back off.
	Per Sheet S-2, all bid repair items shall be shop cleaned in accordance with SSPC-SP 2 and coated with a zinc-rich or epoxy based steel primer. If Phase 2 of the project is awarded, the tank will be sandblasted and fully recoated.
