Note the following changes to the above-mentioned bid. This information is to be taken into consideration when responding to the original bid document.

#### I. General Information

- A. Add to General Specification for all projects:
  - 1. Use 24-gauge galvanized metal for all skirt flashings, other than perimeters, unless otherwise noted.

#### II. Specification Adds, Deletions, and/or Changes:

- A. Argentine Middle School
  - 1. Use 24-guage galvanized metal for all counterflashing including perimeter walls.
  - 2. Add Roof M-1 to base bid. Use same roof replacement scope of work as Roof M. (See attached revised roof plan)
- B. Kansas City Kansas Early Childhood Center
  - 1. Remove all scupper sleeves and replace with 24-guage stainless steel sleeves.
    - a. Strip-in with two plies of trilaminate felt and asphalt mastic.
  - 2. Cover all the tall half-moon interior parapet walls with 2-plies of specified flashing running vertical.
- C. New Stanley Elementary
  - 1. Replace existing metal cover over old chimney with new 24-gauge prefinished cap.
  - 2. Add cleanout hole and removeable panel cover at the bottom four feet of the downspouts.
    - a. Hole shall be approximately three inches round.

- b. Removable panel cover shall match downspout and be approximately 5" x 5".
- c. Provide Alternate Bid to install free standing ballasted OSHA compliant safety rail along the north gutter edge.
  - 1) Submit bids on the attached Revised Bid Form.

## D. Sumner Academy

- 1. Roof 26
  - a. At two 6' x 6' mushroom vent curbs resecure and/or replace termination bar where loose and/or damaged.
  - b. Restore base flashing as specified up to bottom edge of metal mushroom cover.
- 2. Roof 29
  - a. At new outside metal fascia, wrap bottom edge to extend tight against concrete and completely encapsulate wood blocking.
  - b. Replace two existing drains with new 4" cast iron drains, strainers, and connections.
    - 1) Provide a licensed plumbing contractor, approved by district, to remove and install new drains.

### E. Washington High School

- 1. Do not reuse copper reglet counterflashing.
  - a. Remove and replace with new 24-guage, pre-finished, surface-mount counterflashing at all wall flashing.
    - 1) Use double-sided butyl tape for form a gasket between metal counterflashing and masonry walls.
- 2. Reuse existing curb adaptors with exhaust fans.
  - a. If damaged during removal, replace with new to match existing.



## **TIME OF COMPLETION**

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The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees hereby to commence the Work of these Contract Documents on June 1, 2022, and shall complete 100% of the Roofing and Sheet Metal Work no later than August 5, 2022. Work is defined as continuous daily roofing related activities as provided in this specification. If Work cannot be started or completed within specified timeframe, contractor shall provide immediate repairs to stop or minimize leaks until work is completed and shall pay as a late fee the sum of \$1,500 for each consecutive calendar day that work is not started or completed thereafter.

The district reserves the right to cancel the contract if the contractor has not started the work by June 3, 2022. All cost associated with the cancelling of the contract shall be the responsibility of the contractor, including any cost associated with returning materials purchase by the district.

If contractor fails to complete the work by August 5, 2022, all remaining work must be completed on weekends or holidays, and the district shall deduct \$1,500 per day from the contract until work is 100% complete.
