TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT FOR THE

RFP#20-0915 RETENTION POND MAINTENANCE:

1. Entire Contract:

This Agreement represents the entire and integrated Contract between the City and Contractor and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or contracts, either written or oral. The Advertisement for Bids, Bid Form and Agreement are included in the contract documents binding the parties. Provisions of this Contract may be amended only by written instrument approved by the Crestview City Council and signed by the City Clerk and Contractor.

2. Intent of Contract:

**Specifications for contract of Retention / Right of  
way area**

It is the intent of the City of Crestview to contract services to maintain the 184 specified city retention areas in accordance with the following specifications:

1. Description

Work consists of lawn maintenance (on a as needed basis) such as: Grass mowing, weed trimming and proper removal/disposal of lawn litter including trash, but not limited to landscape debris such as sticks by the contractor.

2. Contract period

Length of contract should include two full services of each Retention/Right-of-way area 6 weeks apart, beginning October 2020 and ending September 2021.

3. Specifications for mowing

Lawn maintenance to include: grass mowing, trimming, proper removal and disposal of lawn litter, including trash, and landscape debris such as sticks by the contractor.

4. General specifications and conditions

- A. Inspection of location- Before submitting a bid, bidders shall be held to examine all locations specified herein where work is to be performed, and become satisfied as to the existing conditions under which a contractor will be obliged to operate, that may affect the work under this contract. No allowances shall be made in this connection on behalf of the bidder and or contract, for any negligence on their part.
- B. Insurance requirements- The contractor must provide to the City an insurance certificate and a filled-out W-9 form **before any work for the City may begin**. All insurance policies and certificates must include an endorsement providing (10) ten days prior written notice to the City of cancellation or reduction of coverage. The contractor shall cease operations on the occurrence of any such cancellation or reduction and shall not resume operations until new insurance is in force.

Comprehensive General Liability:

Contractor shall, during the performance of the contract, maintain Worker's Compensation Insurance sufficient to secure benefits of the Florida Workmen's Compensation Law for all employees and any of the work sublet to any vendor or subcontractor, Comprehensive General Liability Insurance, and Auto Liability Insurance, all with companies and in the form and amounts acceptable to the City. If any part of the work is sublet, similar insurance shall be provided by and in behalf of any subcontractors.

- C. Award- Upon notification of contract award by the City, the contractor shall submit to the Cities designated representative, documentation as may be requested or required hereunder. Upon their receipt and subsequent approval by the City, the administrator will contact the contractor and inform them when they may proceed.



- D. Award criteria-Responsiveness to bid and cost.
- E. Contractor Administrator- The City shall be contract administrator herein referred to as the Administrator. The administrator will audit billings, approve payments, oversee schedules, and generally be responsible for overseeing of contract.
- F. Contractor status-The contractor and his/her employees at all times shall be considered as an independent contractor, and not as City employees. As an independent contractor, the contractor's payment under this contract shall not be subject to any withholding for tax, social security, or other purposes; nor shall the contractor or his/her employees be entitled to sick leave, pension benefits, vacation, medical benefits, life insurance or unemployment compensation or the like from the City.
- G. Extras- Prices for extra work requested during this contract which are not part of this contract will be negotiated at the time of occurrence.
- H. Protection of Property - The contractor shall be responsible for protecting and preserving from damage any and all facilities, public and private, which are adjacent to the area where the work is being done.
- I. Accidents- Any accidents on the premises shall be reported to: Administrator-

5. SCOPE OF WORK AND SEPERATION OF RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. CONTRACTOR TO FURNISH-All transportation, all equipment and necessary supplies including but not restricted to: mowers, edger's, blowers and trimmers. The contractor should furnish, operate, and maintain suitable and adequate equipment necessary to perform all tasks described in bid item, in a favorable manner.  
The equipment furnished by the contractor must be in good repair and shall be maintained to produce a clean, sharp cut to the grass at all times. Equipment which in any ways rips grass or damages turf shall not be allowed to operate under this contract. All equipment will be of such type so that the height of cut can be adjusted to a minimum of 2 inches and a maximum of 6 inches. The contractor shall have enough of equipment and personnel to complete each mowing cycle at each site contracted for.
- B. Under no circumstance shall the City be responsible for any theft, vandalism, or any damage to the contractor's equipment due to obstacles encountered during the work to be performed under this contract.

6. Technical Specifications

A. MOWING

- 1. Grass shall be mowed to a minimum height of (2-6) inches.

2. All mowing, trimming, and edging equipment shall be properly maintained. Cutting blades shall be kept sharp to minimize turf damage.
  3. Equipment and supplies may not be stored overnight or for extended periods of time on City property.
  4. Grass shall not be mowed when wet.
- B. GRASS TRIMMING- Trim grass within all Retention and Right of way areas, including large brush, cat tails and other various vegetation. Extreme care shall be used to prevent injury to fixed objects and trees.
- C. INSPECT- Report any obvious damage to Retention / Right of way areas to City. Including wash outs, pipe damage, erosion, fence damage, and property damage.

#### 7. Compensation:

All payments upon contract are contingent upon the Contractor's Work being acceptable to the City. For satisfactory completion and acceptance of the Work, the City agrees to pay the Contractor in accordance with the terms of this Contract.

#### 8. Indemnification:

Contractor covenants and agrees that they will indemnify and hold harmless the City and all of its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims, losses, damages, costs, charges or expenses arising out of any act, action, neglect, or omission by Contractor during the performance of the agreement, whether direct or indirect, and whether to any person or property to which the City or said parties may be liable.

#### 9. Licensing:

The Contractor shall obtain all permits and maintain at its expense all professional and business certificates and licenses required by the City or otherwise by law and as necessary to perform services under this Contract. If Contractor performs any Work without obtaining, or contrary to, permits and licenses, Contractor shall bear all costs arising there from.

#### 10. Performance of Work/Responsibilities:

The Contractor shall commence work in a reasonable length of time and shall complete the work in an expeditious manner. In emergency situations, the Contractor shall endeavor to commence work immediately. All work shall be done under the supervision of the City's Public Service Director or designated representative. The performance of Work and responsibilities hereto are outlined and made a part hereof as identified in "Description of Work".

#### 11. Termination for Default:

The Contract will remain in force for the full period specified and until the City's Public Services Director or his designee determines that all requirements and conditions have been satisfactorily met. However, the City Public Services Director will have the right to terminate this Contract sooner if the Contractor has failed to perform satisfactorily the work required or comply with the other requirements of the Contract.

In the event the City Public Services Director decides to terminate this Contract for the Contractor's failure to perform satisfactorily or meet its other responsibilities under the Contract, the City Public Services Director will give the Contractor five (5) days' notice, whereupon the Contract will terminate, unless during the notice period the Contractor cures the failure to perform or meets its other responsibilities under the Contract to the satisfaction of the City Public Services Director.

Upon Contract termination for the Contractor's failure to provide satisfactory contract performance, the Contractor will be entitled to receive compensation for Contract services satisfactorily performed by the Contractor and allocable to the Contract and accepted by the City Public Services Director or his designee prior to such termination. However, an amount equal to all additional costs required to be expended by the City to complete the Work covered by the Contract, including costs of delay in completing the project, shall be either subtracted from any amount due or amount charged to the Contractor in the event the City Public Services Director terminates the Contract.

Except as otherwise directed by the City Public Services Director, or in the case of termination for default (in which event the Contractor may be entitled to cure, at the option of the City Public Services Director), the Contractor shall stop work on the date of receipt of the notice or other date specified in the notice, place no further orders or subcontract for materials, services, or facilities except as are necessary for the completion of such portion of the work not terminated and terminate all contractor and subcontracts and settle all outstanding liabilities and claims.

*In the event that any termination for default shall be found to be improper or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, then such termination shall be deemed to have been a termination for convenience.*

#### 12. Termination for Convenience:

The performance of work under this Contract may be terminated by the City Public Services Director in whole or in part whenever the City Public Services Director, in his discretion, determines that such termination is in the City's best interest. Any such termination shall be affected by the City Public Services Director giving at least five (5) days' notice to the Contractor, specifying the extent to which performance of the work under this Contract is terminated and the date upon which such termination becomes effective.

As to termination for convenience, after receipt of the date of termination, the Contractor shall stop all work as specified in the notice; place no further orders or subcontract for materials, services, or facilities except as are necessary for the completion of such portion of the Work not terminated; and terminate all contractors and subcontracts and settle all outstanding liabilities and claims.

### 13. Disclosure:

Contractor warrants that it has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the Contractor to solicit or secure this Contract and that it has not paid or agreed to pay any person, company, corporation, individual, or firm, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the Contractor, any fee, commission, percentage, gift, or other consideration contingent upon or resulting from the award or making of this Contract.

### 14. Miscellaneous:

#### 14.1 Governing Law

The parties intend that this Contract and the relationship of the parties shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Venue for any action arising out of this contract shall be in Okaloosa County Florida and nowhere else.

#### 14.2 Severability

If any section, subsection, term or provision of this Contract or the application thereof to any party or circumstance shall, to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of said section, subsection, term or provision of this Contract or the application of same to parties or circumstances other than those to which it was held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby and each remaining section, subsection, term or provision of this Contract shall be valid or enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.

**14.3 PUBLIC ACCESS.** Contractor shall comply with the requirements of Florida's Public Records law. In accordance with Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes, Contractor shall:

- a. Keep and maintain public records required by the public agency to perform the service.
- b. Upon request from the public agency's custodian of public records, provide the public agency with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided under Florida's Public Law or as otherwise provided by law.
- c. Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the contract term and following completion of this contract if Contractor does not transfer the records to the public agency; and
- d. Upon completion of the contract, transfer, at no cost, to the public agency all public records in possession of Contractor or keep and maintain public records required by the public agency to perform the service. If Contractor transfers all public records to the public agency upon completion of the contract, Contractor shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If the Contractor keeps and maintains public records upon completion of this contract, the Contractor shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically must be provided to the public agency, upon request from the public agency's custodian of public records, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of the public agency.
- e. If Contractor has questions regarding the application Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, to Contractor's duty to provide public records relating to this Agreement, Contractor shall contact the Custodian of Public Records at:**

- f. In the event the public agency must initiate litigation against Contractor in order to enforce compliance with Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, or in the event of litigation filed against the public agency because Contractor failed to provide access to public records responsive to a public record request, the public agency shall be entitled to recover all costs, including but not limited to reasonable attorneys' fees, costs of suit, witness fees, and expert witness fees extended as part of said litigation and any subsequent appeals.

#### 14.4 Sovereign Immunity

The parties further agree, nothing contained herein is intended nor shall be construed to waive the City of Crestview's rights and immunities under the Florida constitution, common law or Florida Statutes 768.28, as amended from time to time.

#### 14.5 Construction

The Parties have participated jointly in the negotiation and drafting of this Contract. In the event an ambiguity or question of intent or interpretation arises, this Contract shall be construed as if drafted jointly by the Parties and no presumption or burden of proof shall arise favoring or disfavoring any Party by virtue of the authorship of any of the provision of this contract.

#### 14.6 Attorney's Fees

In any dispute relating to this contract each party shall be responsible for their respective attorney's fees and costs.

#### 14.7 Notices

All notices under the Contract shall be in writing and shall be effective when mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, or when delivered personally, as provided hereafter, or to such other addresses as may be designated by notice:

14.8 The undersigned Contractor in accordance with Florida Statute 287.087 hereby certifies that Contractor shall:

1. Publish a statement notifying employees that the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession, or use of a controlled substance is prohibited in the workplace and specifying the actions that will be taken against employees for violations of such prohibition.
2. Inform employees about the dangers of drug abuse in the workplace, the business's policy of maintaining a drug-free workplace, any available drug counseling, rehabilitation, and employee assistance programs, and the penalties that may be imposed upon employees for drug abuse violations.
3. Give each employee engaged in providing the contractual services that are under bid a copy of the statement specified in subsection (1).
4. In the statement specified in subsection (1), notify the employees that, as a condition of working on the contractual services that are under bid, the employee will abide by the terms of the statement and will notify the employer of any conviction of, or plea of guilty or nolo contendere to, any violation of Chapter 893 or of any controlled substance law of the United States or any state, for a violation occurring in the workplace no later than five (5) days after such conviction.

5. Impose a sanction on, or require the satisfactory participation in, a drug abuse assistance or rehabilitation program if such is available in the employee's community, by any employee who is so convicted.
