CITY OF WHITE HOUSE, TENNESSEE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

I. INTRODUCTION

A. General Information

The City of White House is requesting proposals from qualified companies to provide HVAC maintenance and repairs for several City owned building locations.

There is no expressed or implied obligation for the City of White House to reimburse responding firms for any expenses incurred in preparing Proposals in response to this request.

To be considered, please submit one (1) original and four (4) copies of the proposal sealed in an envelope. The proposal must be received by Mr. Derek Watson, Purchasing Specialist at 105 College Street, White House, Tennessee, 37188 <u>before</u> 12:00 PM on Wednesday, February 24th, 2016. No late proposals will be accepted/evaluated.

The City of White House reserves the right to reject any or all proposals submitted.

During the evaluation process, the City reserves the right to request additional information or clarifications from proposers, or to allow corrections of errors or omissions.

The City of White House reserves the right to retain all proposals submitted and to use any ideas in a proposal regardless of whether that proposal is selected. Submission of a proposal indicates acceptance by the company of the conditions contained in this request for proposals, unless clearly and specifically noted in the proposal submitted and confirmed in the contract between the City of White House and the firm selected.

It is anticipated the selection of a company will be completed by March 17, 2016. Following the notification of the selected firm it is expected a contract will be executed between both parties following the March 17, 2016 meeting of the City of White House Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

B. Term of Engagement

A three (3) year contract is contemplated, subject to the annual review and recommendation of the City departments, the satisfactory negotiation of terms and the concurrence of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of White House. The agreement can be terminated with written notice within 30 days of cancelation from either party.

II. NATURE OF SERVICES REQUIRED

The selected company will be required to provide services including, but not limited to, the following:

- 1. Any equipment that is essential to the company's operation must be provided by the company
- 2. Monthly/Quarterly/Annual maintenance for any and all City owned HVAC units listed in <u>Appendix A</u>
- 3. Provide a "per hour" or any other price list for any repairs that may occur to any and all City owned HVAC units during the contract term
- 4. Any full replacements of HVAC units will be bid out separately from this contract

III. AWARDED PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Must submit at least three (3) references on similar projects
- 2. Must obtain a business license with the City of White House
- 3. Must have experience in managing comparably sized operations
- 4. **Insurance Requirement**-The Contractor shall provide Commercial liability insurance naming the City of White House as an Additional Insured. Proof of Workers Compensation insurance (if applicable) will be required as evidenced by a certificate.

IV. SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

One (1) original and four (4) copies of the company's Proposal shall be submitted to the City of White House no later than 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 24th, 2016. **Please have company information on the outside of the Proposal envelope.**

VI. PROPOSAL OPENING AND EVALUATIONS

Sealed proposals shall be opened after the deadline with the Evaluation Committee only. Selection of a company will be made from all respondents with implementation of services to follow. However, this RFP does not indicate a commitment by the City to award a contract to any respondent. The City intends to evaluate the proposed services based upon the information presented in response to the RFP. The candidates will then be reviewed based on qualifications, past experience, references, familiarity with services and pricing, and then rated according to which company best meets the City's requirements.

Those firms whose proposals most closely meet the needs of the City of White House <u>may</u> be required to attend an interview with the City of White House Administration Staff during the evaluation process.

Nothing herein is intended to exclude any responsible vendor, product or service or in any way restrain or restrict competition. All responsible vendors are encouraged to submit proposal information accordingly as described in this document.

The Tennessee Public Records Act (T.C.A. 10-7-705 (d)) is legislation giving the fullest possible public access to public records. Anyone proposing would need to consult with their attorney regarding confidential submissions and independently seek injunctions to prohibit public disclosure as may be necessary.

By submitting a response to this RFP the vendor commits to be familiar with and agrees to observe and comply with all federal, state, and local laws, statues, ordinances, and regulations.

VII. NEGOTIATIONS

The City retains the right to make an award based on initial proposals without negotiations.

VIII. CHANGES IN PROPOSAL DOCUMENTS

Any communication from the City to a Company will be transmitted simultaneously to all Companies along with written questions submitted. Any Company who fails to recognize or utilize this process of communication will be notified of its violation of the process and may be disqualified. All addenda will be numbered in sequence, dated as of the date of issue, and sent via email, fax, or mail to all Proposers.

IX. VERBAL AGREEMENTS

No verbal agreement or conversation with any officer, agent or employee of the City, either before or after execution of the Contract, shall affect or modify any of the terms or obligations contained in the Contract. Any such verbal agreement or conversation shall be considered unofficial information and in no way binding upon the City or the Contractor.

X. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

The City reserves and holds at its discretion the following rights and options:

- a. Issue addenda to the Request For Proposals, including extending or otherwise revising the timeline for submittals;
- b. Withdraw the Request for Proposals;

- c. Request clarification and/or additional information from the Company at any point in the procurement process;
- d. Execute a Contract with a Company, on the sole basis of the original Proposal;
- e. Reject any or all Proposals, waive irregularities in any Proposal, accept or reject all or any part of any Proposal, waive any requirements of the Request, as may be deemed to be in the best interest of the City; and
- f. Reissue or modify the Request for Proposals.

In order to be considered for selection, responses must be received on or before the date and time specified. Firms mailing responses should allow normal mail delivery time to ensure timely receipt by the City. Proposals received after the stated time shall not be considered. No fax or email transmittals will be accepted.

XI. DISPOSITION OF PROPOSALS

All materials submitted in response to this Proposal will become the property of the City of White House. One (1) copy of each Proposal shall be retained for official files. It is understood that the Proposal will become part of the official file on this matter without obligation on the part of the City of White House. All Proposals become the property of the City upon submission and will not be returned to the applicant.

XII. DISCLOSURE

Any trade secrets or proprietary information submitted by a vendor in connection with this procurement shall not be subject to public disclosure. However, the vendor must invoke the protection of this section prior to or upon submission of the data or other materials by identifying the specific area or scope of data or other materials to be protected and state the reasons protection is necessary. An all-inclusive statement that the entire Proposal is proprietary is not acceptable. A statement that cost Proposals are to be protected is not acceptable. There is no expressed or implied obligation for the City of White House to reimburse responding firms for any expenses incurred in preparing Proposals in response to this request.
