General Information for Vendors

1. **BACKGROUND AND INTENT**

- a. Knoxville's Community Development Corporation (KCDC) is the public housing and redevelopment agency for the City of Knoxville and for the County of Knox in Tennessee. KCDC's public housing property portfolio includes seventeen housing properties with approximately 3,500 dwelling units. KCDC also administers approximately 3,700 vouchers through our Section 8 department and has three tax credit properties.
- b. This is a request for quotes-not sealed bids. KCDC could simply contact three vendors, obtain quotes and move forward but KCDC has chosen to solicit written quotes from all interested parties. However, this is not a formal sealed bid and the normal formal sealed bidding requirements do not apply to this solicitation.
- c. KCDC intends for this solicitation to result in the selection of a vendor to supply LED lights and fixtures for our Autumn Landing apartment complex. This complex is located at 6331 Pleasant Ridge Road in Knoxville, Tennessee 37921-1194. This solicitation does not include installation.
- d. This order must be delivered within eight weeks after KCDC issues its purchase order. The purchase order is expected to be issued the week of August 25th.
- e. If the delivery of all ordered items is beyond the eight week due date, a \$200 per day liquidated damages assessment will be levied.
- f. The items specified below are from Del Mar Lighting LLC. This company is located at 829 Pipers Lane, Brentwood, Tennessee 37027. Their telephone number is 615.376.4566.
- g. Equals may be quoted. However:
 1. Full documentation must accompany the request and it must clearly indicate all factors that make it an equal.
 2. KCDC will be the sole determiner of "equal" status of proposed products.
 3. Requests for declaration of equality must be made ASAP and are to be directed as noted in paragraph 5 below.
- h. Prices quoted are to be inclusive of all charges involved in the delivery of the products to Autumn Landing (or other designated KCDC location).
- i. All LED lights are to be included with the fixtures.
- j. Due to the short time line allowed for ordering, vendors are encouraged to ask if they are in KCDC procurement system. If not, vendors will be asked to supply the two required registration forms (W9 and the Vendor Verification Form) before the due date.

3. Certificate of Independent Price Determination

(a) The bidder/offeror certifies that—

(b) The Contractor agrees that if after award he or she discovers an organizational conflict of interest with respect to this contract, he or she shall make an immediate and full disclosure in writing to the HA which shall include a description of the action which the Contractor has taken or intends to eliminate or neutralize the conflict. The HA may, however, terminate the Contract for the convenience of HA if it would be in the best interest of HA.

(c) In the event the Contractor was aware of an organizational conflict of interest before the award of this Contract and intentionally did not disclose the conflict to the HA, the HA may terminate the Contract for default.

(d) The Contractor shall require a disclosure or representation from subcontractors and consultants who may be in a position to influence the advice or assistance rendered to the HA and shall include any necessary provisions to eliminate or neutralize conflicts of interest in consultant agreements or subcontracts involving performance or work under this Contract.

5. Authorized Negotiators (RFPs only)
