The City will disqualify any bid not received on or before 2:00 PM local time on January 19, 2021. Shortly after the deadline for the submission of bids, bids received on time will be publicly opened and read aloud. The Sixth Floor Conference Room of Canton City Hall is the location for the bid opening.

Submit all bids to the City of Canton Purchasing Department, 218 Cleveland Avenue SW, Purchasing Department/Fourth Floor, Canton, Ohio 44702 according to the instructions in the Invitation to Bid posted on the City of Canton Purchasing Department website at https://cantonohio.gov/448/Purchasing-Procurement.

A certified check or cashier's check made payable to the City of Canton must accompany the bid. Draw this check from a solvent bank satisfactory to the Director of Public Service as a guaranty the contract and its performance are properly secured if the bid is accepted. The Bidder shall verify the certified check or cashier's check for five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. The City of Canton will only accept original checks. Therefore, if any company and/or bidder submits a copy (including faxed copies) of his/her \$500.00 security, the City will disqualify the bid.

Should any bid be accepted, the check will be deducted from the total amount owed to the City once the scrap has been properly removed as outlined in the bid, and an invoice has been issued by the City. Should any bid not be awarded or be rejected, such check will be returned to the bidder or bidders after the execution of the contract.

Any bidder may withdraw his bid, by written request, at any time prior to the deadline set for the bid opening. Please be advised, the City of Canton may impose a \$500.00 penalty to any bidder that withdraws his bid after the bid opening and prior to a contract award(s).

Each bid must contain the full name of every person or company participating in the bid.

The Board of Control reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to accept the bid(s) deemed most beneficial to the City of Canton.

SPECIFICATIONS

1.0 SCOPE AND CLASSIFICATION

- 1.1 **Scope**: The City of Canton, Traffic, Sign and Paint department, is seeking bids for the Sale of Scrap Metal (Appendix A) and Wood (Appendix B). The scrap is located at 2506 CLEVELAND AVE S, Canton, OH 44707, the Traffic, Sign and Paint Facility. The bid is for only scrap items, e.g.- light poles and bases, metal barrels, barrel lids and lid clamps, miscellaneous street signs and posts, a scrap fuel pump and wood pallets.
- 1.2 **Classification**: The scrap will be awarded to the person or company who bids the highest price per ton for the metal and highest lot price for the wood.

2.0 APPLICABLE PUBLICATIONS & STANDARDS

3.0 REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 General Requirements
- 3.1.1 Price: All bidders are requested to bid fixed, firm pricing in the spaces provided on the proposal page. Bidders shall bid a price per ton for the metal and a lot price for the wood.
- 3.1.2 Quantity: The total amount of scrap metal will be determined after the bids are opened and the scrap metal is weighed.
- 3.1.3 Time: After the bids are opened, they will be reviewed and evaluated prior to making an award by the Board of Control. Therefore, it will be at least two (2) weeks or longer after the bid opening before an award letter will be sent out and the scrap metal and wood can be removed.
- 3.2 Procedural Requirements
- 3.2.1 The scrap can be viewed at the Traffic, Sign and Paint Facility 2506 CLEVELAND AVE S, Canton, OH 44707 by appointment only. To set up a time to view the scrap metal and/or wood, please contact Supervisor, Scott Whipkey at 330-438-6685.
- 3.2.2 The bidder with the highest bid will be awarded the contract(s). The City reserves the right to award to one bidder for both the metal and wood or award to two bidders, one for the metal and one for the wood, whatever is determined to be in the City's best interest.

- 3.2.3 The successful bidder(s), prior to picking up the awarded scrap metal, will be required to arrange with the Traffic, Sign and Paint Department for an employee to accompany the successful bidder's truck driver to a weigh station, to be determined by the City, in order to witness the weighing of said truck when it is both loaded with the scrap metal and when it has been emptied. The successful bidder is responsible for all scale fees for this purpose. The successful bidder for the scrap wood will be required to arrange with the Traffic, Sign and Paint Department for an employee to be present while the scrap wood is loaded.
- 3.2.4 The successful bidder will be responsible for loading the miscellaneous scrap onto their truck(s) identified in specification 3.2.3. When the truck is loaded with the scrap metal, the driver will drive to the weigh station, again accompanied by the Traffic, Sign and Paint Department employee(s), who will witness the weighing of the loaded and unloaded truck. The successful bidder will then be required to submit a copy of the weigh slip(s) to the Traffic, Sign and Paint Department.
- 3.2.5 The successful bidder will have seventy-two (72) hours upon receipt of the award letter to remove the awarded scrap.
- 3.3 Specifications: Scrap metal may consist of more than one type of metal that the City cannot separate. The scrap will be sold as is. There will be no deduction for dirt, corrosion, etc.

4.0 SAMPLING, INSPECTION, AND TEST PROCEDURES

4.1 The scrap can be viewed, prior to bid submittal, in accordance with the procedures outlined above in Sections 3.2.1.

5.0 INVOICING AND PAYMENT

- 5.1 After the scrap metal has been picked up, the City will invoice the successful bidder for the scrap metal as indicated from the weigh slip(s). No checks are to be submitted to the City until the Department has issued an invoice for the total amount due to the City. The successful bidder for the scrap wood will be required to submit their check to the City prior to pick-up. Alternate payment may be arranged for the scrap wood by contacting the Purchasing Department.
- 5.2 The bid check (\$500.00) will be deducted from the total amount owed to the City once the scrap metal has been properly removed as outlined in the bid.

6.0 NOTES

- 6.1 Proposal Page Instructions: Bidders are required to fill out the proposal page. Pricing found elsewhere in the bid will not be considered. Price shall include all of the requirements listed in the specifications.
- 6.2 Questions and Addenda
- All questions should be submitted in writing at least five (5) business days prior to the date and time of the bid opening. Answers to questions will be issued in writing as official addenda no later than seventy two (72) business hours prior to the time of the bid opening. Said addenda will become a component of the Invitation to Bid and should be acknowledged as received on the proposal page. Failure to acknowledge all official addenda in this manner may result in your bid being disqualified.

The following standard indemnity agreement and minimum insurance requirements are incorporated in the specifications for all work performed by the Contractor for the Owner, its affiliated and associated organizations or subsidiaries, hereinafter referred to as Owner.

- I. The Contractor agrees to indemnify and save the Owner harmless from and against any and all costs, loss and expense, liability damages, or claims for damages, including cost for defending any action, on account of any injury to persons (including death) or damage to or destruction of property of the Owner, arising or resulting from the work provided for or performed, or from any act, omission, or negligence of the Contractor, Subcontractor and his or their agents or employees. The foregoing provisions shall in no way be deemed released, waived or modified in any respect by reason of any insurance or surety provided by the Contractor.
- II. The Contractor shall maintain liability insurance and furnish the Owner with Certificates of Insurance as evidence thereof in the prescribed form. If any work provided for or to be performed under any Specifications is sublet (as otherwise permitted by the terms of such Specifications), the Contractor shall require the sub-contractors to maintain and furnish him with satisfactory evidence of Workmen's Compensation, Employer's Liability and such other forms and amounts of insurance which Contractor deems reasonably adequate.
- III. In accordance with Item II, the Contractor shall maintain the following insurance:

- 3. not be subject to any of the special property damage liability exclusions commonly referred to as the XCU exclusions pertaining to blasting or explosion, collapse or structural damage and underground property;
- 4. provide the City of Canton "additional insured status" and shall contain an endorsement by the insurance carrier providing thirty (30) days' notice to both the City and insured in the event of any change in coverage under the policy. No less than thirty (30) days advance notice of cancellation of the insurance policy shall be given to the City by the insurer.
