The Project consists of the following major work elements at the Moccasin Bend Wastewater Treatment Plant Detritors Facility: Demolition/removal of various mechanical, structural, and electrical elements; removal and replacement of the existing grit collector/separator and reciprocating rake mechanisms at Detritors 1 and 2; installation of new slide gates with electric actuators; miscellaneous concrete structure modifications and additions; concrete surface cleaning, restoration, and coating at various locations; cleaning and coating of existing odor control duct supports; temporary bypass pumping, miscellaneous electrical improvements; miscellaneous metal fabrication modifications and improvements; and other miscellaneous improvements.

Dust Control

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, prepared on the form of Bid Bond attached to the Contract Documents or a Surety Company's Standard Bid Bond, duly executed by the Bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Tennessee and listed as a certified company in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570, in the amount of five percent of the Bid.

The contract time shall be 300 calendar days. The 300 calendar days include 120 days for submittals review, material/equipment procurement, development of construction sequence, etc., and 180 days for work to be executed on site. The Owner may grant permission to commence work on site early if some of the required components have been procured and are ready for installation. However, commencement of work on site will also initiate the 180-day onsite construction portion of the overall contract time.

No bid may be withdrawn within 120 calendar days after the scheduled time for receipt of bids.

All bidders must be licensed and shall comply with all requirements of the State of Tennessee Contractor's Licensing Act.
