Sealed Proposals for the construction of the City of Lebanon, Tennessee Department of Public Services, Sewer and Water Line Relocations for Briskin Lane, City Project No. CL 14017, will be received at the office of the City of Lebanon, Tennessee Department of Public Services, 200 North Castle Heights Avenue, Suite 300, Lebanon, Tennessee 37087, **Attention: Regina Santana** on or before 10:00 AM. local time on Thursday, February 4, 2021 and immediately thereafter all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project will include the following described construction:

The furnishing, installing, and testing of approximately 1,925 linear feet of 10-inch SDR 26 PVC gravity sewer mains, including installing proposed 10" PVC sewer inside a 16" steel casing pipe under Briskin Lane; 4-foot dia. manholes, 6" PVC sewer services; 6" PVC service clean-out assemblies and traffic rated clean-out boxes; handling wastewater flows, Kor-N-Seal tie-ins to existing manholes; approximately 680 linear feet of 8-inch CI 200 water main, DIP fittings, 6-inch gate valves with boxes, fire hydrant assemblies, sleeved connections, tapping sleeve and valve connection to existing 8" and 12" water mains, service reconnections, working in and in close proximity to the roadways and other utilities, testing, topsoil and seeding of disturbed areas, property restoration, and all other appurtenances, unclassified excavation, sediment/erosion control; backfill and other work as shown on the Construction Drawings or indicated in the Contract Specifications.

Official (numbered) Bid Documents shall be obtained at the office of Water Management Services, LLC, 2 International Plaza, Suite 401, Nashville, Tennessee 37217 (telephone: (615-366-6088). A non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 must be made for each set obtained.

The City of Lebanon, Tennessee further reserves the right to reject all Proposals.
