SPECIFICATIONS FOR DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION OF AN ODOR CONTROL UNIT (Hydroxl radical based odor control unit) CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE MOCCASIN BEND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

1.0 GENERAL

1.1 SCOPE OF SERVICES:

1. The Vendor shall provide and install a hydroxyl radical based odor control unit for the treatment of sanitary sewer structures.

1.2 BID PROPOSAL:

The following information will be submitted with all bids:

- 1. Primary materials of construction of the unit.
- 2. Number of delivery points of oxidant supplied by the unit.
- 3. Volume of airspace treated per unit.
- 4. Unit Dimensions.
- 5. Power requirements per unit.
- 6. Other physical requirements the unit needs to function.

1.3 BASIS OF BIDDING

The Vendor shall submit one (1) bid on the City's Standard Bid Form. The Bid shall include the cost per hour for labor and percent markup on materials and specialized equipment that may be required by the Vendor.

The Vendor shall provide a 30-day trial period of the unit at no cost to the City of Chattanooga. At the conclusion of the trial period, the City shall elect to purchase the unit, or return the unit to the Vendor. The Vendor may provide a "demo" unit for the purpose of the trial period if and only if the intended permanent unit is identical, and there is no lapse in service from the Vendor.

The unit costs in the bid schedule shall include any and all, costs for wages, benefits, indirect costs, overhead and profit, insurance, and any other related direct or indirect cost.

Cost of these services shall be subject to all of the requirements of the Specifications.

The bid shall be awarded on the basis of the unit cost to provide the desired units for Waste Resources Division - ISS as well as an evaluation of the proximity, experience, capabilities, chemical properties and other factors of the Vendor and their submitted products as specified in the City Code.

The City of Chattanooga reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, to waive any information in Bids received, and to accept any Bid which in its opinion may be in the best interest of the city.

2.0 PRODUCT

2.1 PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

The product specified herein is described as follows:

An oxidant based odor control unit for use in sanitary sewers. Hydroxl radicals shall be the oxidant used for odor control. The unit shall operate using potable water and a 120V power supply only.

2.3 OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The unit shall have capability to deliver oxidant to two (2) separate delivery points.
- 2. The unit shall operate on a 120V power supply with a maximum current draw of 17 A.
- 3. The unit shall be capable of treating 10,000 cubic feet.
- 4. The unit shall include a 1 year warranty from the date of installation.

3.0 EXECUTION

3.1 SHIPMENT OF PRODUCT:

Delivery of Product to the sanitary sewer junction box adjacent to the vacant lot located at 3802 Memphis Drive, Chattanooga, Tennessee 37415 shall be delivered during business hours Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 pm. Prior notification shall be issued to Moccasin Bend personnel to ensure an operator will be on site to take delivery and facilitate installation.

SDS sheet shall accompany all shipments of producta

3.2 Unloading of Product:

All personnel in the unloading area, including the delivery driver and city personnel must wear all appropriate personal protective equipment.

The delivery driver or support personnel will be responsible to clean up any spills of product for any reason.

Any claims or damage or demurrage (other than that provided for in this contract) by the vendors delivery truck company will be directed to the Vendor, it will be the responsibility of the Vendor to make such claims to the City.

The Delivery driver company shall not dismantle or adjust any of the City's equipment, piping, or tanks without permission of the City representative.

4.0 PAYMENT AND PENALTIES

4.1 Payment:

Payment shall be in accordance with the City's normal payment process.
