Bids can be delivered on or before **10:00 a.m. CST, Friday, February 16, 2018** at **Belle Meade City Hall, 4705 Harding Road, Nashville, Tennessee 37205**, or submitted electronically via the City website for the **Electrical Service – Video & LPR Camera Surveillance System Project**.

Description of Work & Bidder Information:

The City of Belle Meade will accept sealed lump-sum bids from licensed electricians for labor and materials necessary to install the City's Video & LPR Camera Surveillance Project. This work includes installation of electrical service for surveillance cameras on 17 utility poles at various intersections in the City. A list of the utility pole numbers and locations is included in the Attachments to these Bid Specifications. Also included in the Attachments are Utility Pole diagrams and construction cover maps from Nashville Electric Service (NES), which show the height for the riser on each pole. NES requires the riser to be six (6) inches **below** the neutral line, and the disconnect will need to be at the camera cabinet instead of directly below the meter base, in order to prevent anyone from switching it to the off position. NES also requires all brackets to be lagged to the pole – metal straps are no longer permitted.

The successful bidder will be responsible for obtaining all electrical permits and releases for this work from the Metro Nashville/Davidson County Codes Department, and providing evidence of such to the City of Belle Meade.

The project shall be completed fully within 45 working days (defined as Monday through Friday) after the award of the contract. The Contractor is responsible for providing any traffic control as may be necessary during working hours. Liquidated Damages in the amount of \$200.00 may be assessed for each consecutive calendar working day that expires after the time period specified above for completion of the Project.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any one or all bids received. No bidder may withdraw a submitted Bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Each Bidder is responsible for inspecting the sites and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the Contract Documents. By signing the Bid, the Bidder certifies that he has investigated the site conditions of the Project, fully satisfied himself of the conditions, and based his Bid accordingly. The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect to his Bid.

Separate sealed bids will be received (whether hand delivered or sent online via the City website) in accordance with the Bidding Requirements, by the City of Belle Meade, 4705 Harding Road, Nashville, TN 37205 until 10:00 AM, CST, on Friday, February 16, 2018. Bids will subsequently be publicly opened and read aloud. However, the successful bidder may not be determined until the next Commissioner's meeting on Wednesday, February 21, 2018.

Contractor Requirements:

The Contractor (and/or subcontractor) shall be licensed for the classification of work required for the Project in accordance with Public Chapter No. 822 (House Bill No. 2180) "Contractors Licensing Act of 1976," passed March 18, 1976 by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, and any subsequent amendments thereto, or any Rules and Regulations promulgated by the State Board of Licensing Contractors and approved by proper legal authority. The entire wording of the Act shall be considered to be included by reference to these Contract Documents.

Indemnity and Insurance Requirements – It is specifically understood and agreed between the parties that the Contractor shall indemnify City, defend and save it harmless against any and all claims, causes of action and/or suits which may be presented or brought, arising out of the conduct of the Contractor or any of its employees, servants or agents or subcontractors, in the performance of this agreement. In furtherance of this agreement for indemnity, but not by way of limitation thereof, Contractor shall obtain and keep in effect during the term hereof, and any extension, at his own expense, policies of insurance, indemnifying itself, and the City against all claims, causes of action and other liabilities or whatsoever kind and nature arising out of, or in any way connected with its activities pursuant to this contract, such insurance to cover:

- Workers Compensation benefits as required under the statutory limits for the State of Tennessee,
- General Liability to include damages for Bodily Injury, Property Damage, and Personal Injury in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence with a two million dollar (\$2,000,000) annual aggregate.
- Automobile Liability to include owned, hired, and non-owned motor vehicles in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence.

In addition to Insurance Certificates for the above coverages, an ENDORSEMENT NAMING THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS AN ADDITIONAL INSURED is required for the Liability and Automobile coverages.

Drug-Free Workplace Affidavits – T.C.A. §50-9-113. Effective January 2001, any contractor with five or more employees who provides construction services for the state or any local government is required to submit an affidavit stating that the contractor has a drug-free workplace program in compliance with the Tennessee Drug-Free Workplace Act, T.C.A. §50-9-101 through 50-0-113. The Drug-Free workplace affidavit is to be submitted with the bid for this project. This statute directs that no local government shall award any construction contract to a contractor who does not submit such an affidavit with its bid.

Iran Divestment Act Contractor Certification – TCA Title 12, Chapter 12. Effective July 1, 2016, each bidder must certify that they are not on the list of entities ineligible to contract

with the State of Tennessee or any of its political subdivisions. The Iran Divestment Certification form must be submitted with the bid for this project.

On the outside of each envelope containing a Bid, the Bidder shall show the following information; otherwise, the Bid will not be opened:

The Owner reserves the right to reject any Bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such Bidder fails to satisfy the Owner that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Agreement and to complete the Work contemplated therein.

CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT made this _____ day of _____ in the year TWO THOUSAND and EIGHTEEN (2018) and _____ by and between _____ hereinafter called the Contractor, and the City of Belle Meade, 4705 Harding Road Nashville, Tennessee 37205, hereinafter called the Owner.

WITNESSETH, that the Contractor and the Owner for the considerations hereinafter named agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1.

Scope of the Work – The Contractor shall furnish all of the materials and perform all of the work described in the Specifications entitled: **Electrical Service – Video & LPR Camera Surveillance System Project – 2018**. The services to be rendered under this contract are those of an independent contractor. The contractor is not an officer, employee, or agent of the City of Belle Meade.

Indemnity Requirement – The Contractor further agrees to protect, defend, and save the City of Belle Meade, its elected and appointed officials, agents, employees and volunteers while working in the scope of their duties as such, harmless from and against any and all claims, demands, and causes of action of any kind or character, including the cost of their defense, arising in favor of the Contractor’s employees or third parties on account of bodily or personal injuries, death or damage to property arising out of services performed or omissions of services in any way resulting from the act or omissions of the Contractor and /or its agents, employees, subcontractors, representative or the City of Belle Meade under this agreement.

Compliance With Laws – The Contractor must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws including the prevailing wage laws. The Contractor shall procure and maintain for the duration of the contract, at his/her own expense, insurance indicating General Liability to include damages for Bodily Injury, Property Damage, and Personal Injury in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence with a two million dollar (\$2,000,000) annual aggregate and Automobile Liability to include owned, hired, and non-owned motor vehicles in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence, with an endorsement naming the City of Belle Meade as additional insured. The Contractor shall furnish to the City a Certificate of Insurance indicating such coverage. The Contractor is to also furnish a Certificate of Insurance indicating coverage under a Workman’s Compensation Policy that meets the State Minimum Requirements. The Contractor is responsible for work-related injuries of the Contractor’s employees and subcontractors. The Contractor must provide all equipment and supervision for this contract and assume responsibility for all uninsured subcontractors. The policies described herein shall be issued by insurance companies that are licensed to conduct business in the State of Tennessee. The Contractor must provide a thirty (30) day prior notice of cancellation, non-renewal, or material change in coverage.

ARTICLE 2. Time of Completion – The work to be performed under this Contract shall be commenced on _____ and shall be completed on _____

The project shall be completed fully within 45 working days (defined as Monday through Friday) after the award of the contract. Liquidated Damages in the amount of \$200.00 may be assessed for each consecutive calendar working day that expires after the time period specified above for completion of the Project.

ARTICLE 3. The Contract Sum – The Owner shall pay the Contractor for the performance of the Contract, subject to Additions and Deductions provided therein, in current funds as follows:

Where the quantities contemplated are so changed that application of the agreed Lump Sum Amount to the quantity of work performed is shown to create a hardship to the Owner or to the Contractor, there shall be an equitable adjustment of the Contract to prevent such hardship.

ARTICLE 4. Progress Payments – The Owner shall make payments on account of the Contract as provided therein, as follows:

On or about the first day of each month ninety-five (95%) percent of the value, based on the Contract prices, of labor and materials incorporated in the work and of materials suitably stored at the site thereof up to the last day of that month, less the aggregate of previous payments.

ARTICLE 5. Acceptance and Final Payment – Upon receipt of written notice that the work is ready for final inspection and acceptance, the City shall promptly make such inspection, and when it finds the work acceptable under the Contract and the Contract fully performed, it shall release the entire balance found to be due the Contractor, including any retained percentage, and remit payment to the Contractor within thirty (30) days after the date of said final inspection.

Before issuance of final payment, the Contractor shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Owner that all payrolls, material bills, and other indebtedness connected with the work have been paid.

The making and acceptance of the final payment shall constitute a waiver of all claims by the Owner, other than those arising from unsettled liens, from faulty work appearing after final payment or from requirements of the Specifications, and of all claims by the Contractor, except those previously made and still unsettled.

If, after the work has been substantially completed, full completion thereof is materially delayed through no fault of the Contractor, the Owner shall, without terminating the Contract, make payment of the balance due for that portion of the work fully completed and accepted. Such payment shall be made under the terms and conditions governing final payment, except that it shall not constitute a waiver of claims.

ARTICLE 6. The Contract Documents – The General Conditions of the Contract, the Specifications, together with this Agreement, form the Contract, and they are as fully a part of the Contract as if hereto attached or herein repeated.
