# **CRA Entrance Signs Overview & Specifications**

Two (2) Signs - Double-Sided, Free-Standing, Dimensional Sign Design, Construction and Installation:

- Sign to be made from high density polyurethane with a faux wood grain background
- Raised letters, borders and graphics
- Sign supported with 2- 4" x 4", 6' tall posts (color and style to be determined by design)
- Sign posts are to be set in concrete
- Actual sign width and height will be a total of 48" wide with 36" in height
- Sign design details and color scheme to be finalized with the awarded company prior to construction
- One Sign will be located in ROW on E Street; Second sign to be located along W Street
- Contractor to provide two sign design options. Signs will be similar in style. The name of the district and background color will be different on each face.
  - Revisions may be requested
- Quote shall include cost for sign design, construction, installation, and necessary permitting for the signs
  - Per Sec. 5-8.6.a.d.7 in the Code of Ordinances, redevelopment gateway signs are exempt from sign permits
- Contractor to verify location of underground utilities (#811)
- Contractor must submit examples of previous designed and installed signs with quote/proposal

#### Sign 1 (Double-Sided) - E Street - see location map:

**Englewood Redevelopment District** – on south face of sign

Palafox Redevelopment District – on north face of sign

#### Sign 2 (Double-Sided) - W Street (1700 N W Street) — see location map:

**Englewood Redevelopment District** – on north face of sign

**Brownsville Redevelopment District** – on south face of the sign

Insurance: The Contractor is required to carry the following insurance:

- (a) Commercial General Liability, Form CG1, with \$1,000,000 per occurrence. Excess or umbrella insurance may be purchased to make up the difference, if any, between the policy limits of the underlying policies
- (b) Business Automobile Liability with \$1,000,000 per occurrence minimum combined single limits for all hired, owned, and non-owned vehicles.
- (c) Florida statutory Workers' Compensation or proof of exemption.
