To Whom It May Concern:

Williamson County is accepting bids for paving materials (Hot Mix) for the Williamson County Highway Department. Williamson County is proposing to resurface various roads throughout the County. Williamson County is also requesting bids of additional paving materials which the Highway Department may use at their discretion. All quantities may be increased or decreased as required. Please quote prices F.O.B. your plant. Each bid shall include the location of the plant that will furnish mix required by the County.

Williamson County is also requesting bids for asphalt millings furnished by the Highway Department. The millings will be delivered to the asphalt plant and the County will receive credit to be used toward asphalt purchased.

All estimates are subject to change depending on the availability of State and County funds.

All paving materials, construction methods and acceptance testing shall be in accordance with the "Standards Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" of the Tennessee Department of Transportation dated January 1st 2021 and amendments thereto.

The contractor shall, prior to material being provided to the County, submit a TDOT approved job mix formula and quality control plan.

No recycled material will be used in the paving materials to be picked up at the plant by the Williamson County Highway Department with the exception that there is an alternate for "B" Modified that can be used instead of virgin mix if the highway department chooses to do so.

All unit prices bid shall be valid from July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023. The Tennessee Department of Transportation special provision number 109B regarding price adjustment for bituminous material will be used if the "Monthly Bituminous Adjustment Factor," published by TDOT on the first day of each month, increases or decreases by more than 5% from the May, 2022 publishing.



Bid - Hot Mix
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A contract for paving materials to be picked up at the plant by the Williamson County Highway Department will be awarded to all qualified bidders. Williamson County Highway Department will use the State of Tennessee Haul Formula and overall job costs when determining which supplier will be used for a specific project.

State of Tennessee Haul Formula

\$0.50 for the 1st mile, \$0.10 for the 2nd mile up to the 19th mile,
\$0.09 for the 20th mile and above

Bids will be opened May 12, 2022, **2:00 p.m.** Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope to the office of the County Mayor, 1320 West Main Street, Suite 125, Franklin, Tennessee 37064. Each envelope shall be plainly marked: **Bid - Hot Mix, May 12, 2022, 2:00 p.m.. Company name and address must also appear. If the above information does not appear, the bid will not be opened.**

Williamson County reserves the right to reject any and/or all proposals, to waive technicalities or informalities and to accept any proposal deemed to be in the best interest of Williamson County. No bid shall be valid unless signed. No bids shall be submitted by FAX machine. Any exceptions to the bid specifications shall be noted in each bid.

The mix designs shall be prepared by a certified mix design technician from materials including any additives for mix that may be required to be used by the County. All mix designs shall be approved by the Tennessee Department of Transportation and/or the Engineer

NOTE: The Contractor will be responsible for furnishing mix designs for all bituminous plant mix pavement *to be used by the County for State Aid projects. The mix designs shall be prepared by a certified mix design technician from materials including any additives that may be required to be used by the County.* All mix designs shall be approved by the Tennessee Department of Transportation and/or the Engineer. The mixes furnished shall be in accordance with the Tennessee Department of Transportation State Aid Guidelines.

NOTE: The Hot Mix for this contract is being let under the QA guidelines with the exception that the Producer, not the County, will be responsible for running the tests and filling out the daily reports required by T.D.O.T. on hot mix. The cost for this work by the Producer will be included in the price bid for hot mix.

NOTE: This project is being let contingent upon State Aid Funds being available and cannot be started until after July 1, 2022, and the Commissioner of Transportation has signed the contract.

NOTE: Any additives required will be included in the unit price bid for hot mix.

NOTE: All items are being bid FOB. All Surface Mixes to be virgin material only.
