

Sealed Bids: The Jones County Board of Commissioners will accept sealed bids for the construction of the project entitled **New Deep Well Water Supply**, until **October 27, 2020 at 1:30 p.m.** local prevailing time at the Jones County **Government Center at 166 Industrial Blvd., Gray, Georgia 31032**. All Bids will be publicly opened and read. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) calendar days.

Contractor License: Any Contractor submitting a bid must be licensed well driller by the State of Georgia and be fully insured and bonded. License numbers must be written on the face of the bid envelope. No bid will be opened unless it contains the Contractor's license number. See Instructions to Bidders for additional bidding requirements.

Work to Be Done: The work to be done shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to construct the project titled **New Deep Well Supply** as shown on the construction drawings. In general, construction consists of the construction of a new deep well water supply as detailed in the specifications, installation of pump, motor, valves, piping, painting, electrical, videotaping, logging, 24-hour pump test, driveway fencing, SCADA, and testing. Depth is expected to be  $\pm 250$ -feet.

This work will be awarded in one contract with a contract time of 120 days.

Bonds: All bid forms must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid. The successful bidder, if awarded the Contract, will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount. All bonds must appear on the Treasury Department's most current Circular 570 Listing, latest edition.

Funding: Any Contract or Contracts awarded under this Advertisement for Bids are to be funded through SPLOST and local funds from the Jones County Board of Commissioners.
