Any claim by a bidder of error in its bid must be made in compliance with section 5100et seq. of the Public Contract Code. Prior to publicly reading aloud bids at the video conference, the District reserves the right to verify the genuineness of any bid security.

To bid on this Project, the Bidder is required to be registered as a public works contractor with the Department of Industrial Relations and to possess **one or more of the following State of California Contractor Licenses**: [A – General Engineering Contractor, C36 – Plumbing Contractor, C42 – Sanitation System Contractor]. The Bidder's license(s) must remain active and in good standing throughout the term of the Contract.
