Vendor will be responsible for the removal and proper disposal of all delivery and packing materials. Vendor will also be responsible for the removal and disposal of the old equipment that is being replaced.

Service Plan: Any available service plans or maintenance plan costs that will enhance the longevity of the equipment needs to be included as an option. It will need to include the name of the Maintenance Vendor that will being doing the work if sub-contracted by the original Vendor. The plans need to include what services are performed at the time of maintenance and what the expected maintenance schedule be, (i.e., monthly, bi-monthly, quarterly, etc..). Bid may be awarded with or without enrollment in the offered plan.
