- 3. Please replace page 2-4.5 2-4.8, Division 2 Bid Requirements, Section 4 Bid Form with revised page 2-4.5R 2-4.8R provided with this addendum. Revision includes removing item 38 60" DIP S CLASS and is highlighted in yellow.

## **QUESTIONS**:

1. Bid item 38, 60" DIP-S Class 50. 60" pipe is not manufactured in a thickness class 50. It is manufactured in pressure classes 150, 200, 250, 300, and 350 only. Please clarify on how to proceed for bid item 38.?

#### Answer:

2. Will award be based on each line item pricing or total bid package?

#### Answer:

The award will be based on the total bid package.

3. The bid form states that vendors must provide pricing and manufacture for every bid item. McWane Ductile does not manufacture ductile iron pipe above 36" and would have to purchase those sizes from another approved manufacturer. I'm not even sure now much if any, 42" and 60" pipe the county would purchase as the quantities listed seem to be a placeholder.

#### Answer:

Please refer to Division 4.1.7 Manufacturers must bid and be able to supply all sizes of pipe in the bid.



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4. Please clarify the restrained joint pricing should just be the additional cost that would be applied to the slip joint base price and not the sum of those costs which would be the actual cost of the pipe.

#### Answer:

Please refer to Division 2 section 4 Restrained joint pipe shall be bid as a add on based on per foot price.

5. Please clarify the note about pressure class options. Are we to provide the price difference between the special class base and the pressure class alternate or simply insert the cost of the pressure class pipe?

## Answer:

Please refer to Division 2 section 4 Pressure class option shown as a deduct on a per foot bases.

6. As a manufacturer located outside of the state of GA, our company does not employ any GA residents. Is it necessary for McWane Ductile to submit the GA Security & Immigration compliance form?

#### Answer:

7. Our corporate offices are closed due to the Covid-19, will Clayton County except an E-Signature on these documents.
