LEBANON WTP SECONDARY SALT STORAGE TANK

Sealed proposals for the construction of the City of Lebanon, Lebanon WTP Secondary Salt Storage Tank, will be received at the office of the City of Lebanon Department of Public Services, City of Lebanon Administration Building, 200 North Castle Heights Avenue, Lebanon, Tennessee 37087, Attention: Mr. Jeff Baines on or before 10:00 A.M. local time on Thursday, September 19, 2019 and immediately thereafter all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project will include the following described construction:

Furnishing and installation of a new 52-ton brine storage tank adjacent to the existing brine storage tank, as well as, a relocation of approximately 65 LF of 6-inch ductile iron water main, together with all required piping, equipment, plumbing, heating, electrical, grading, demolition, and appurtenances as required.
