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# Background

The Spalding County Water and Sewerage Facilities Authority (SCWSFA), established in 1982 as a public corporation, was created for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, equipping, maintaining, and operating water supply, treatment, and distribution facilities and sewage collection, treatment, and disposal within its statutorily defined special district, being comprised of unincorporated Spalding County. Until 2009, the only service provided by the SCWSFA was potable water.

On December 3, 2009, the SCWSFA began providing sewer service when it purchased an existing wastewater treatment plant from a textile manufacturing facility. The sewer infrastructure acquired consisted of one (1) wastewater treatment plant (WWTP), two (2) lift stations, approximately three (3) miles of gravity mains (various sizes), and one (1) mile of sewer force mains (various sizes). Currently, the SCWSFA customer base consists of 15,163 water customers and 121 sewer customers.

The SCWSFA decided in late 2020 to decommission its WWTP and transfer the existing sewer service area to the City of Griffin (COG) for ownership. The existing sewer service area transfer was completed in February 2022, and all sewer flow treated at the COG's Cabin Creek WWTP. That said, barring unforeseen circumstances, the SCWSFA WWTP will be decommissioned and the associated NPDES permit terminated by December 31, 2022.

With the decommissioning of the WWTP, the only available sewer providers in Spalding County will be the COG and a private sewer system owned and operated by Community Services, LLLP. The private sewer system is located in the County's northeast part and serves the Sun City Peachtree subdivision and various adjacent parcels.

The SCWSFA understands the vital role water and wastewater infrastructure plays in driving economic development and wants to commission a sewer feasibility study (Study) for the following four (4) target areas.

- Area #1 Newnan Road West Corridor west of the City of Griffin city limits along Newnan Road from West Poplar Avenue to the Coweta County/Spalding County line
- Area #2 Arthur K Bolton (AKB) East Corridor east of the City of Griffin city limits along AKB from Barrow Road to the Butts County/Spalding County line
- Area #3 North Expressway North Corridor north of the City of Griffin city limits along North
  Expressway to the Henry County/Spalding County line
- Area #4 Tri-County Corridor south of the City of Griffin city limits along Martin Luther K Jr Parkway from Airport Road to the Lamar County/Spalding County line

#### Area #1 - Newnan Road West Corridor

This area has been selected to address the residential housing pressure migrating east along Newnan Road out of Coweta County.

#### Area #2 – Arthur K Bolton (AKB) East Corridor

This area has been identified as an area primed for industrial expansion.

## Area #3 – North Expressway North Corridor

This area has been chosen based on the potential future growth of commercial development. It should also be noted that various businesses within this area have aging or failing septic systems.

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#### Area #4 - Tri-County Corridor

This area falls within the COG's sewer service area, currently under a sewer moratorium stalling commercial growth in the area. The issued sewer moratorium is due to capacity constraints within the existing collection system. The COG has stated they would give up this service area minus their existing sewer customers to the SCWSFA. This area has been identified as an area primed for commercial growth.

Please refer to Figure 1.0 for the locations of the target areas.

# **Project Goals**

The ultimate goal of the sewer feasibility study is to provide an actionable plan regarding the most economical way to provide sewer services to support the future needs of four (4) target areas. The SCWSFA understands that the most economical solution may come in the form of a centralized sewer system, decentralized sewer systems, possible intergovernmental agreements, or a combination.

A detailed scope of work will be developed with the chosen Firm.

# **Project Schedule**

The anticipated project schedule from the Notice to Proceed (NTP) is approximately nine (9) months.

## Fee Estimate

The SCWSFA will negotiate the final scope and fee to the best-qualified Firm. Upon successful negotiation of scope and fee a contract will be awarded.

# Selection Method

#### Method of Communication

All general communication of relevant information regarding this solicitation will be made via the Spalding County website and the Georgia Procurement Registry website. All firms are responsible for checking the Spalding County website (https://www.spaldingcounty.com/) or the Georgia Procurement Registry website (https://ssl.doas.state.ga.us/gpr/) on a regular basis for updates, clarifications, and announcements. The SCWSFA reserves the right to communicate via email with the Project Manager listed in the RFQ. Other specific communications will be made as indicated in the remainder of this RFQ.

# Selection

Based on the Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) submitted in response to this RFQ, the Selection Committee will rank the Proposal submissions in order by the most qualified firms using individual scores. Depending on the number and quality of the proposals, the Selection Committee may shortlist one or more firms for further consideration.

All firms must meet the minimum requirements listed in the Instructions for Preparing Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) Proposal section below.

#### **Finalist Notification**

Firms will receive a notification from the SCWSFA primary contact outlining the findings of the Selection Committee. This notification communication will either notify firms of the intended selection or provide

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instruction for additional information or interview instructions. Criteria for the remainder of the selection process will be communicated in the Finalist Notification.

#### Interview

At the discretion of the Selection Committee, an interview may be requested with the shortlisted Firm (s). Each finalist firm shall be notified in writing and informed of the interview session's place, date, and time. Detailed interview instructions and requirements of the finalists will be provided in the Notification to Finalist. Firm(s) shall not address any questions, before the Interview, to anyone other than the SCWSFA primary contact.

NOTE: Scoring and ranking from the previous qualification round will NOT be used in the final selection round.

#### Final Selection

Upon completion of the selection process by the SCWSFA Selection Committee, the shortlisted firms will be ranked in descending order of recommendation using the sum of individual rankings from the Selection Committee members. Negotiations will then be initiated with the top-ranked Firm to finalize the terms and conditions of the contract. If a satisfactory agreement cannot be reached with the highest-ranking Firm, the SCWSFA will formally terminate the negotiations in writing and enter into negotiations with the second-highest-ranking Firm assuming two firms have been found to be sufficiently qualified based upon the review of the SOQ, and so on until a mutual agreement is established and the SCWSFA awards a contract.

## Selection Criteria

# Criteria for evaluation of the Statement of Qualifications Proposals

The SCWSFA Selection Committee will evaluate all firms using the following criteria:

- 1 Qualifications as they relate to this sewer feasibility study (40%)
  - Firm's experience with similar projects
  - Qualifications of proposed key personnel
  - Communication skills (ability to easily explain technical information to people of various backgrounds)
- 2 Firm's project understanding and technical approach (30%)
- 3 Apparent ability to provide the required services in a timely manner (15%)
- 4 Firm's reputation for integrity and competence (15%)

# Instructions for Preparing Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) Proposals

The SOQ Proposals must be submitted in accordance with the instructions provided below. All submissions must be <u>categorized and numbered</u> as outlined below and must be responsive to all requested information:

Minimum Requirements – Firms must perform these minimum requirements to be fully considered.

#### ALL FORMS ARE TO BE COMPLETED BY PRIME AND ANY SUB-CONSULTANTS.

# A. Certification Form (Exhibit I enclosed with RFQ)

Complete and provide a notarized original within the Firm's SOQ Proposal. (This one-page form submission shall not be considered part of the required page limit specified in Instructions within the Submittal of Statement of Qualifications Proposal section below.)

# B. Immigration and Security Form (Exhibit A enclosed with RFQ)

Complete and provide a notarized original within the Firm's Statement of Qualifications Proposal. (This one-page form submission shall not be considered part of the required page limit specified within the Submittal of Statement of Qualifications Proposal section below.)

# C. Immigration and Security Form Affidavit Verifying Status for County Public Benefit Application (Exhibit B enclosed with RFQ)

Complete and provide a notarized original within the Firm's Statement of Qualifications Proposal. (These form submissions shall not be considered part of the required page limit specified within the Submittal of Statement of Qualifications Proposal section below.)

#### D. W-9 form (enclosed with the RFQ)

Complete and provide an original within the Firm's Statement of Qualifications Proposal. (This one-page form submission shall not be considered part of the required page limit specified within the Submittal of Statement of Qualifications Proposal section below.)

#### E. Cover Letter

This letter shall be a brief formal letter from the Firm that provides information regarding the Firm and its ability to perform the requirements of this solicitation. The cover letter must include the following information:

- Complete legal name of the company (as it should appear in a contract)
- Company address
- Contact person, telephone number, and email address
- Identify all materials and enclosures being forwarded in response to this solicitation
- The cover letter must be signed by an individual authorized to bind the proposing entity

# F. Project Understanding

The SOQ shall describe the Firm's understanding of the sewer feasibility study goals, including background, purpose, and key issues. The Firm shall demonstrate an understanding of the SCWSFA's goals and objectives related to the sewer feasibility study.

# G. Technical Approach

This section should include a thorough description of the Firm's approach and methodology to assess the most economical way to provide sewer to the target areas. The Firm is encouraged to highlight innovative ideas relevant to this solicitation. A preliminary schedule should accompany the approach and methodology taken.

## H. Project Team

Provide a brief overview of the Firm and identify local and regional offices, including sub-consultants required to perform the sewer feasibility study successfully. Provide a specific organizational chart identifying key project personnel by name, title, work office location, Georgia Professional Engineering Registrations, and the areas of expertise for which each team member will be responsible. If sub-consultants are used, each sub-consultant shall be identified and how their expertise relates to the sewer feasibility study.

#### I. Experience and Project References

Describe the specific projects the proposed personnel for this sewer feasibility study have worked on within the past five (5) years, with clients' contact names and phone numbers. Including at least three (3) projects of similar approach and methodology. For each project, indicate which proposed team member worked on the project(s) and describe the role/work they performed. Emphasis should be placed on the Firm's, or individual team members' experience related to sewer feasibility studies or projects of similar nature.

#### J. Resumes

Please include resumes for each proposed team member limiting the resumes to two (2) pages.

# Instructions for Submittal of Statement of Qualifications Proposal

<u>One (1) original</u> and <u>seven (9) copies</u> of the Proposal shall be prepared, for a total of <u>eight (10) sets</u>. One complete copy of the Proposal must be submitted electronically as a PDF via a flash drive. Each Proposal shall be identical and include a transmittal letter signed by a duly authorized officer of the Firm.

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The proposals should be concise, well-organized, and demonstrate the Consultant's and individual team members' qualifications related to the proposed nature of the sewer feasibility study.

For efficient review, please restrict the Proposal to a total <u>not-to-exceed limit of 20 pages</u>, 8.5 by 11 pages, including preprinted material, charts, design write-ups, graphics, forms, pictures, etc. The minimum font size for the Proposal is 12-point. For exhibits, 11 by 17 pages are allowed and welcomed to enhance readability. The 20-page limit does not include the cover letter, dividers, resumes, reference letters, DBE/WBE certifications, affidavits, appendices, and front or back covers included in the Proposal. Fancy bindings, colored displays, and promotional materials are left to the Respondent's discretion. Emphasis must be on completeness, relevance, and clarity of content.

Proposals must be sealed in an opaque envelope or box and reference **RFQ 2022 - 007.** The words **"STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS PROPOSAL"** must be clearly identified on the outside of the envelopes or boxes. The Spalding County Purchasing Department must physically receive the SOQ Proposals prior to the deadline indicated in the Schedule of Events at the exact address below. <u>Proposals submitted via facsimile or email will be rejected.</u>

#### No proposal will be accepted after the time and date set for receipt.

Proposals must be prepared simply and economically, providing a straightforward, concise description of the methodology and approach utilized to satisfy the requirements of this solicitation. Emphasis should be on completeness and clarity of content with sufficient detail to allow for accurate evaluation and comparative analysis.

The SCWSFA will not be liable for costs incurred by the respondents in preparing this SOQ.

All SOQs, upon receipt, become the property of the SCWSFA. Labeling information provided in the Proposals "proprietary" or "confidential" or any other restricted use designation will <u>NOT</u> project the information from public view. Subject to the Opens Record Act provisions, the details of the Proposal documents will remain confidential until the project's final award.

## Debriefings

Debriefings may be allowed at the discretion of the SCWSFA. Post-award debriefings may be requested by a principal of the Firm but will not be conducted until after the contract has been awarded. A pre-award debriefing may be requested if a firm is notified of non-selection at any time during the procurement process.

#### Questions/Clarification Request

## Terms and Conditions

- 1. Spalding County shall in all solicitations or advertisements for subcontractors or employees placed by or behalf of the County, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, handicap, religion, creed or belief, political affiliation, race, color, sex or national origin. Spalding County shall not discriminate against any qualified client or recipient of services provided on the basis of age, handicap, religion, creed or belief, political affiliation, race, color, sex or national origin. Spalding County shall cause forgoing provisions to be included in all subcontracts for any work covered by this project so that such provisions will be binding upon each subcontractor, provided that the foregoing provisions shall not apply to subcontracts for less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
- 2. Firms shall comply with the applicable provisions of the Hatch Act which limits the political activity of employees.


- 1. To determine which respondents, if any, shall be included on a shortlist of semi-finalists based on criteria outlined in this RFQ;

## **Purpose of Form**

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

• Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding, later.
