Such notification must be submitted in writing and must be received by the Purchasing Division no later than ten (10) days prior to the bid opening date.

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**SECTION 1.0 - INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING BID RESPONSE FOR ITB 19-003:**

1. Bidders are expected to examine this bid form and all instructions. Failure to do so will be at the bidder's risk.
2. All prices and notations must be in ink or typewritten. No erasures are permitted. Mistakes may be crossed out and corrections typed adjacent and must be initialed and dated in ink by person signing bid. All bids must be signed with the firm name and by a responsible officer or employee.
3. Each bidder shall furnish all the information required on the bid form and each accompanying sheet on which he/she makes an entry.
4. Unit price for each unit bid shall be shown. A total shall be entered in the amount column for each item bid. In case of discrepancy between a unit price and extended price, the unit prices will be presumed to be correct.
5. Although the City generally awards bids based on a "lump sum" basis to the bidder submitting the lowest responsive and responsible total bid as shown on the Invitation to bid cover sheet, the City may choose to award on a "per group" or "per item" basis. ## SECTION 2 -GENERAL CONDITIONS

2.1 **EXECUTION OF BID:** Bid must contain a manual signature of an authorized representative in the space provided. Florida law requires that when a municipality enters into a contractual agreement with a corporation licensed to do business in the State of Florida, such agreement shall be signed by two (2) Corporate Officials (i.e., President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer) with the corporate seal affixed. It is also required that such execution be acknowledged before a Notary Public with Notary Seal affixed. If neither the aforementioned corporate officers nor the corporate seal are readily available, a letter of authorization can be submitted in lieu of these requirements. Such letter of authorization must be on the corporate stationery, must clearly state that the person who signed the referenced agreement is duly authorized to enter into such agreement on behalf of the corporation and must be signed by the corporate officials designated above. Failure to submit letter of authorization within two (2) weeks after notification of award may result in award to the next apparent low bidder.

2.1.1 In the case of a partnership, the agreement must be signed by a general or managing partner and notarized as outlined above.

2.1.2 In the case of a sole proprietorship, the owner must sign the agreement and have such execution notarized.

2.2 **SUBMITTAL OF BIDS:** Bids shall be submitted utilizing the bid form(s) provided by the City. All bids shall be properly executed with all blank spaces filled in. The signatures of all persons signing shall be in longhand. Erasures, interlineations, or other corrections shall be authenticated by affixing in the margin immediately opposite the correction the initials of a person signing the bid. If the unit price and the total amount named by a bidder for any item are not in agreement the unit price alone shall be considered as representing the bidder's intention, and the totals shall be corrected.

2.3 **AMENDMENT OF THE INVITATION TO BID:** It is the bidder's responsibility to contact the Purchasing Division prior to submitting a bid to ascertain if any addenda have been issued, to obtain all such addenda, and return executed addenda with the bid (or complete and sign addenda acknowledgement form.) The failure of a bidder to submit acknowledgment of any addenda that affects the bid price(s), is considered a major irregularity and will be cause for rejection of the bid.

2.4 **BIDDER'S CERTIFICATION FORM:** Each bidder shall complete the "Bidder's Certification" form included with this invitation to bid, and submit the form with the bid. The failure of a bidder to submit this document will be cause for rejection of the bid.

2.5 **SPECIFICATIONS REQUIRED:** All items quoted must be in compliance with the specifications. If you are taking exception, indicate those exceptions on company letterhead and attach to this invitation to bid.

2.6 **ALTERNATIVES/SUBSTITUTIONS TO SPECIFICATIONS:** Any alternatives or substitutions to the attached specifications must be clearly delineated, set out and submitted with the bid (use separate sheets of paper and make them part of the bid).

2.7 **PRICES, TERMS, and PAYMENT:** All prices must be firm for the delivery schedule quoted in the specifications. Bids stipulating "Price in effect at time of shipment" or other similar conditions will be considered not responsive to the bid invitation and will not be accepted. All prices shall be quoted F.O.B. delivered to any City of Fort Walton Beach department unless otherwise stipulated in the bid invitation. Bidder is requested to offer cash discount for prompt invoice payment. It is the policy of the City of Fort Walton Beach to make payments of invoices in time to earn any offered cash discounts. Discount time will be computed from the date of satisfactory delivery at place of acceptance or from receipt of correct invoice at the Finance Department office, whichever is later.

## 2.8 **TRADE NAMES**

2.8.1 In cases where an item is identified by a manufacturer's name, trade name, catalog number, or reference, it is understood that the bidder proposes to furnish the item so identified and does not propose to furnish an "EQUAL" unless the proposed "EQUAL" is definitely indicated therein by the bidder.

2.8.2 The reference to a name brand is intended to be descriptive but not restrictive and only to indicate to the prospective bidder articles that will be satisfactory. Bids on other makes and catalogs will be considered provided each bidder clearly states in his bid or proposal exactly what he proposes to furnish and forwards with his bid a cut illustration or other descriptive matter which will clearly indicate the character of the article covered by his bid.

2.8.3 The City hereby reserves the right to approve as an equal, or to reject as not being equal, any article the bidder proposes to furnish which contains major or minor variations from the specification requirements but may comply substantially therewith.

2.8.4 If no particular brand, model, or make is specified and if no data is required to be submitted with the bid, a bidder may be required to submit working drawings or sufficient detailed descriptive data to enable the City to determine if such specification requirements are met.

2.9 **DISCOUNTS:** Bidders may offer a cash discount for prompt payment; however, such discounts shall not be considered in determining the lowest net cost for bid evaluation purposes. Discount will be computed from the date of satisfactory delivery at place of acceptance or from receipt of correct invoice at the office specified, whichever is later. Bidders are encouraged not to reflect cash discounts in the unit prices bid.

2.10 **EFFECTIVE PERIOD:** Prices quoted in the bid must remain open for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of bid opening.

## 2.11 **QUESTIONS REGARDING SPECIFICATIONS OR BIDDING PROCESS:**

2.11.1 Respondents are advised that from the date of release of this solicitation until award of the contract, **no contact with City personnel related to this solicitation is permitted. All communications are to be directed to the Purchasing Representative and sole contact listed below in section 2.11.4.**

- 2.11.2 Any questions related to interpretation of specifications or the bid process shall be addressed to the Purchasing Agent, in writing, in ample time before the period set for the receipt and opening of bids. No inquiries, if received within ten (10) days of the date set for the receipt of bids, will be given any consideration. Any interpretation made to prospective bidders will be expressed in the form of an addendum to the specifications which, if issued, will be conveyed to all prospective bidders no later than five (5) days before the date set for receipt of bids. Oral answers will not be authoritative.

2.12.2 **RECEIPT OF BIDS, DUE DATE:** Sealed bids shall be submitted to the Purchasing Division Office no later than **2:30 PM (CST), on February 5, 2019**. Bids shall not be accepted after this time and date. Each bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope marked with the bid number, title of the bid, and bid opening date.

2.13 **NO BID FORM:** In the event you elect not to bid, please respond by returning the "NO BID" Response Form with the reason for not bidding. To qualify as a respondent, bidder must submit a "BID" or "NO BID" and it must be received no later than the stated bid opening date and time. Repeated failure to bid without sufficient justification shall be cause for removal of the supplier's name from the bid list.

2.14 **WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS:** Bidders may withdraw a bid after it has been deposited with the Purchasing Division's Office any time before the scheduled time for opening the bids.

2.15 **BID OPENING:** The bid opening shall be public, on the date and at the time specified on the bid form. It is the bidder's responsibility to assure that their bid is delivered at the proper time and place of the bid opening. Bids which for any reason are not so delivered will not be returned but will be retained in the "BID FILE" unopened. Offers by telephone for a sealed bid cannot be accepted.

2.16 **AWARD OR REJECTION OF BIDS:** The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder(s) complying with all the provisions of the Invitation to Bid, provided the bid price is reasonable, and it is in the interest of the City to accept it.

2.16.1 The City of Fort Walton Beach reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality in bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in the best interest of the City. The City of Fort Walton Beach also reserves the right to reject the bid of a bidder who has previously failed to perform properly or complete, on time, contracts of a similar nature, or a bid of a bidder who an investigation shows is not in a position to perform the contract.

2.16.2 Award will be made in approximately sixty (60) days. It is incumbent on bidders to contact the Purchasing Division at (850) 833-9523 to determine the successful bidder(s). Bidders or respondents who do not agree with the City Council's award are afforded the opportunity to protest the recommendation by submitting a written vendor protest to the Purchasing Division within three (3) business days after City Council has awarded the purchase. Failure to file a written vendor protest within three (3) business days shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under this policy.

2.16.3 In the best interest of the City, the right is reserved to make award(s) by individual items, group of items, all or none, or a combination thereof, with one or more suppliers; to reject any and all bids, or to

waive any informality or technicality in bids received.

**2.17 SELECTION / REJECTION OF OPTIONS / ALTERNATIVES:** If an invitation to bid permits options or alternatives, the City reserves the right to select or reject any or all options or alternatives that are bid and as deemed to be in the best interests of the City.

**2.18 PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES:** A person or affiliate, as defined in § 287.133, Florida Statutes, who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit bids on leases of real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in § 287.01, Florida Statutes, for Category Two, for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list. **2.22 MISTAKES:** Bidders are expected to examine the specifications, delivery schedules, bid prices, and all instructions pertaining to supplies and services. Failure to do so will be at the bidder's risk.

**2.23 CONDITION and PACKAGING:** It is understood and agreed that any item offered or shipped as a result of this bid shall be new and the current production model at the time of this bid, unless otherwise specified. All containers shall be suitable for storage or shipment, and all prices shall include standard commercial packaging.

**2.24 SAFETY STANDARDS:** Unless otherwise specified in the bid, all manufactured items and fabricated assemblies shall comply with applicable requirements and standards of the Occupational Safety and Health Act.

**2.25 MARKING:** Each individual container shall be marked with the brand name of the product, quantity and the name and address of the manufacturer. Each shipping container shall include the name of the vendor and must also clearly indicate the City of Fort Walton Beach Purchase Order Number.

2.27 **CONFLICT OF INTEREST:** Any award of contract for this Invitation to Bid is subject to Chapter 112, Florida Statutes. All bidders must disclose with their bid the name of any officer, director, or agent who is also an employee of the City of Fort Walton Beach. Further, all bidders must disclose the name of any City of Fort Walton Beach officer, director, or employee who owns, directly or indirectly, an interest of ten percent (10%) or more of the bidder's firm or any of its branches or who has any contractual relationship or agreement of any kind with the bidder. The bidder warrants that no one was paid a fee, commission, gift, or other consideration contingent upon receipt of an award for the services and/or supplies specified herein.

2.28 **INSPECTION, ACCEPTANCE, AND TITLE:** Inspection and acceptance will be at the destination point unless otherwise stipulated by the City. Title and risk of loss or damage to all items shall be the responsibility of the shipper (vendor) until accepted by the using department of the City of Fort Walton Beach, unless loss or damage results from negligence by the City of Fort Walton Beach or its Departments.

- 2.34.1 Contractor shall keep and maintain public records required by the City to perform the services contained in this Agreement. Upon request from the City's custodian of public records, Contractor shall provide the City with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the costs provided for in Chapter 119, Florida Statutes or as otherwise provided by law.

## **SECTION 4 – SCOPE OF WORK AND SPECIFICATIONS**

### **4.1 INTENT**

It is the intent of this solicitation to secure a controls/instrumentation/electrical contractor to perform specified construction related to the relocation of the City of Fort Walton Beach's (City) Hypertac Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) Central Telemetry Site from the City's Utility Services Department at 203 Hollywood Boulevard NW, Fort Walton Beach, FL to the antenna tower adjacent to the City's Fire Station No. 7 at 1968 Lewis Turner Boulevard NE, Fort Walton Beach, FL. The scope of services for this contract will be for all labor and materials needed to complete the work specified herein.

### **4.2 BACKGROUND**

The current telemetry system installed is manufactured by Data Flow Systems (DFS) Inc., Melbourne, Florida.

- 4.2.1 The central telemetry site will be relocated to Fire Station No. 7. Part of this facility houses the transmitter room for the City's communications system. The former dispatch office is now used by the fire crews for exercise training.
- 4.2.2 The Relocation of the City's Hypertac SCADA Central Telemetry Site is necessary given the following:
  - 4.2.2.1 The City's Hypertac SCADA Central Telemetry Site is currently located at the existing Utility Services Field Office. However, this Field office will be vacated at the end of 2019, and the SCADA equipment must be relocated.

4.2.2.2 Relocating the City's Hypertac SCADA Central Telemetry Site from a ground elevation of 16 feet above sea level to a ground elevation of 53 feet above sea level will provide for increased protection from a hurricane storm surge.

4.2.2.3 System coverage reliability will be increased by using a City-owned radio tower.

4.2.3 This relocation will provide superior unobstructed coverage of the City's water and sewer system operation via telemetry.

### **4.3 SUMMARY OF WORK**

4.3.1 All work identified in this bid shall be completed by the successful bidder and include all necessary materials, labor, and equipment needed to complete the specified work.

4.3.2 Work performed by the Contractor shall include the complete relocation of the City's Hypertac SCADA Central Telemetry Site. For the purposes of this bid, the City will be responsible for providing noted materials. (See Section 4.4).

4.3.3 The Contractor shall be responsible for restoring the surrounding work area to its original condition.

### **4.4 MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT**

4.4.1 The Contractor shall assume full responsibility for the coordination of the installation of all equipment, materials, and products. The Contractor shall be completely responsible for verification that all structures and equipment components furnished by him and/or his subcontractors and suppliers are compatible.

4.4.2 Equipment shall be readily adaptable for installation and operation in the structures. No responsibility for alteration of a planned structure to accommodate other types of equipment will be assumed by the City. Equipment that requires alteration of the structures will be considered only if the contractor assumes all responsibility for making and coordinating all necessary alterations. No equipment requiring alteration of structures shall be installed without prior written approval by the City. All such alterations shall be made at the Contractor's expense.

4.4.3 The Contractor shall guarantee all equipment against faulty or inadequate design, improper assembly or erection, defective workmanship, defective materials, breakage or other failure. See Section 4.4.7.

## 4.5 SCOPE OF WORK

- 4.5.1 The Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining and paying for all necessary local and state licenses and permits. A City Building Permit is required.
- 4.5.2 The Contractor will be required to deliver all equipment and other materials to the installation site. Care shall be exercised in handling all materials and equipment, and the Contractor will be held responsible for all breakage or damage to same. Material and equipment may be delivered to places that will not interfere with other construction operations and unloaded or yarded and distributed as required, at the Contractor's discretion.
- 4.5.3 Sequence of Events:
- 4.5.3.1 The Contractor shall install the new central processing cabinet, conduits, and wiring to cabinet. Coordination with the City's IT Department will be required for both telephone lines and internet.
- 4.5.3.2 The Contractor shall establish circuitry for the RTU and run fiber optic out to the antenna.
- 4.5.3.3 The Contractor shall install the antenna on the tower and wire it to the RTU.
- 4.5.3.4 The Contractor shall relocate the RTU from the City's Utility Services Department to Fire Station No. 7 by first shutting down the system and then relocating all hardware associated with the central unit and RTU. Concurrently, the City will be responsible for re-aiming all remote site antennas.
- 4.5.3.5 The Contractor will be responsible for turning the system back on and ensuring its proper function.

## 4.6 SPECIFICATIONS FOR PROPOSED WORK

- 4.6.1 The Contractor shall be responsible for all labor and materials needed for the installation of the proposed conduits and raceways including but not limited to labor, material, heavy equipment, shoring, trenching, and any required dewatering. All wall penetrations shall be properly sealed and all conduits shall be secured to all wall systems in the proper manner.
- 4.6.1.1 The Contractor shall provide a 120 VAC source voltage circuit from the mechanical room located in Fire Station No. 7 to the installation of the proper circuit breaker in the existing load panel and to the circuit out to the DFS SCADA tower enclosure.
- 4.6.1.2 An additional 1-inch Schedule 40 PVC conduit will also be required from the DFS SCADA tower enclosure to the DFS

SCADA server enclosure that will be in the weight training room of Fire Station No. 7. City personnel will assist in developing the conduit underneath the driveway utilizing the City's hammerhead mole, although the Contractor is required to be onsite and provide all required materials. The conduit shall house the required fiber optic. The Contractor shall be responsible for providing all required lengths of fiber and the installation of the proper fiber connections at each end. All fiber connections shall be properly polished and verified.

- 4.6.2 Cabling shall be contiguous from the connection of the base antenna to the bulkhead arrester mounted on the DFS SCADA enclosure. No splicing shall be allowed. All cable ends shall be properly prepared to receive the proper connections. All cable termination points shall be properly weatherproofed with electrical tape and splicing tape and covered with cold shrink. The Contractor is responsible for determining all connectors required to deliver a complete and operational RF antenna assembly.
- 4.6.3 The base antenna shall be mounted at a minimum of 160 feet above ground level. All mounting hardware shall be installed at a maximum of 24-inch spacing with no exceptions. The use of plastic cable ties for fastening the cable to the tower structure is not permissible. The Contractor is responsible for providing all aerial equipment needed for antenna installation and wiring.
- 4.6.4 The Contractor shall be responsible for mounting the DFS SCADA server enclosure in the weight training room of Fire Station No. 7. The development of all required conduits for the source voltage requirements of the enclosure as well as the two (2) required phone lines from the adjacent communications closet shall be expected of the Contractor. The Contractor shall be responsible for terminating the phone line circuits at the punch down blocks located inside the closet.
- 4.6.5 Each potential bidder is responsible for verifying cable lengths and the quantities required for clamps, stand-off adaptors, snap-in rings, member adaptors, and stainless hardware required to construct the antenna assembly as specified.
- 4.6.6 The Contractor will relocate the existing CTU to a location near the existing antenna tower assembly.
- 4.6.7 The Contractor shall provide tapered tower sections, one (1) 4-foot tapered base tower section and one (1) 9-foot tapered top tower section, with the appropriate hardware for assembly. The Contractor shall embed all but the top 6 inches of the 4-foot tapered base section in concrete at the base of the existing tower. The Contractor will mount the City provided DFS RTU enclosure to the above grade 9-foot tapered top tower section.
- 4.6.8 The Contractor is responsible for providing the proper bulkhead arrester and installing in the DFS enclosure and performing all proper grounding.

- 4.6.9 The provision of 120 VAC, telephone lines, and network connections is the City's responsibility. The City will have two (2) new phone lines installed by Century Link to the weight training room of Fire Station No. 7 phone terminal. The phone numbers to be assigned to the two (2) separate phone lines shall be the responsibility of the City.
- 4.6.10 The City currently has internet connectivity within Fire Station No. 7. The Contractor will coordinate with the City's IT department before making any connections to the internet.
- 4.6.11 The Contractor will be responsible for the removal of the existing television and television stand in the weight training room of Fire Station No. 7. The Contractor will be responsible for the installation of the new flat panel television and wall mounting hardware in a position not to interfere with the DFS server and operator station.

#### **4.7 COORDINATION & PROJECT MEETINGS**

- 4.7.1 During the course of this work, the Contractor shall be responsible for keeping the City and Fire Department informed of the proposed work schedule. This includes coordinating material deliveries and any other scheduled work that could impede operations.
- 4.7.2 The Contractor shall not put workers on the job or perform any work without prior knowledge that such work is to be done, the place of work, and the scheduled starting time. A minimum 48-hour notification to the City is required. The City reserves the right to deny the request without penalty.
- 4.7.3 The Contractor shall schedule a preconstruction meeting and site visit with City staff prior to any work being performed. The date, time, and location shall be mutually agreed upon by the City and the Contractor.

#### **4.8 PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE**

- 4.8.1 Within thirty (30) days after Notice to Proceed (NTP) is issued, the Contractor shall submit shop drawings and/or manufacturer's description sheets for the following materials and/or equipment for the approval of the City Engineer:
- All materials listed in the section 4.6, "List of Contractor Provided Materials"
  - All proposed asphalt pavement mix;
  - Ready-mix concrete design;
  - Premixed grouts and mortars;
  - All paints and protective coatings; and
  - Grass seed, fertilizer, sod, and commercial mulches.
- Drawings and manufacturer's descriptive material shall include sufficient detail to clearly establish that the item submitted meets the specifications.

- 4.8.2 The Contractor shall have 30 days to Substantial Completion after Mobilization to the Site. **See Section 3.2.**
- 4.8.3 Deviations to Schedule – Any change to the proposed schedule shall be mutually agreed upon by the City and Contractor. The City reserves the right to alter the projected schedule based on need.

#### **4.10 FINAL INSPECTION**

- 4.10.1 Upon notice from the Contractor that work is completed in accordance with the specifications, the City shall make a final inspection of the work. The Contractor will be notified of all instances where his work fails to comply with the specifications. The Contractor shall immediately make those alterations which will make the work fully comply with the specifications.
- 4.10.2 The Contractor shall immediately correct or complete all issues as well as defects that were identified by the City or a City representative.
- 4.10.3 Upon completion of the repair work the Contractor shall notify the City when it is ready for inspection. The City shall make a final inspection of the work and notify the Contractor of any necessary repair work that is not completed. The Contractor shall immediately complete all incomplete work and arrange for re-inspection.

#### **4.11 PAYMENT**

The cost of work and all costs incidental thereto shall be included in the price bid for the item to which the work pertains.
