BICYCLE / PEDESTRIAN COUNTERS

The City of Chattanooga is determining a vendor for 5 bicycle, 5 pedestrian, and 1 real time display, automated count stations. These stations will be permanent installations and are to wirelessly transmit data to a publicly accessible web service.

Minimum specifications:

- Pedestrian counters are to wirelessly transmit volume and direction data
- Pedestrian counters are to have a minimum range of 12 feet
- Pedestrian counters are to count all passing pedestrians and cyclists (ability to differentiate is a plus)
- Bicycle counters are to wirelessly transmit volume data (option of direction data is a plus)
- Bicycle counters are to have a minimum range of 6 feet
- Bicycle counter detectors are to be flush mounted or otherwise non-invasive
- Visible components of counters should blend with an urban environment
- Counters and related hardware shall be weather-proof, rust-proof, and vandal-proof
- All hardware required for mounting and installation shall be included
- All counters should have at least a 2 year battery life
- All counters shall record data in, at least, 15 minute intervals
- All counter data should wirelessly transmit in real time for web-based viewing, mapping, and public access
- All counters to provide at least 85% accuracy
- All counters to operate year round in typical weather of Chattanooga, TN
- Software to report, chart, graph, and map data shall be included
- The real time display counter should include a digital displays, of at least 6 digits, that advances as each cyclist or pedestrian passes (ability to differentiate is a plus)

Affirmative Action Plan

The City of Chattanooga is an equal opportunity employer and during the performance of this Contract, the Contractor agrees to abide by the equal opportunity goals of the City of Chattanooga as follows:

1. The Contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or handicap. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and the employees are treated during employment without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or handicap. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising, layoff or termination, rates of pay, or other forms of compensation, and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The Contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices setting forth the provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The Contractor will send to each labor union or representative of workers with which he/she has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice advising the said labor union or workers' representatives of the Contractor's commitments under this section, and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.
4. In all construction contracts or subcontracts in excess of \$10,000 to be performed for the City of Chattanooga, any contractor and/or subcontractor is further required to file in duplicate within ten (10) days of being notified that it is the lowest responsible bidder, an affirmative action plan with the EEO Director of the City of Chattanooga. This plan shall state the Contractor's goals for minority and women utilization as a percentage of the work force on this project.
5. This Plan or any attachments thereto shall further provide a list of all employees annotated by job function, race, and sex who are expected to be utilized on this project. This plan or attachment thereto shall further describe the methods by which the Contractor or Subcontractor will utilize to make good faith efforts at providing employment opportunities for minorities and women.

During the term of this contract, the Contractor upon request of the City, will make available for inspection by the City of Chattanooga copies of payroll records, personnel documents and similar records or documents that may be used to verify the Contractor's compliance with these Equal Opportunity provisions.

6. The Contractor will include the portion of the sentence immediately preceding paragraph 1 and the provisions of paragraphs 1 through 6 in every subcontract so that such provisions will be requested of each subcontractor. The Contractor agrees to notify the City of Chattanooga of any subcontractor who refuses or fails to comply with these equal opportunity provisions. Any failure or refusal to comply with these provisions the Contractor and/or Subcontractor shall be a breach of this contract.
