INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

Bids will be received on or before *June 7, 2023* at the office of the *City of Belle Meade*, 4705 Harding Road, Nashville, Tennessee 37205, telephone 615-297-6041, at 10:00 a.m. local time for the *Gravity and Sewer Line Cleaning and Television Inspections Project*.

Description of Work & Bidder Information:

The project consists of high velocity cleaning and televising of sewer lines, inspection of manholes, and supplying the City with reports and DVD recordings of the findings of the projects for approximately 14,164 linear feet of gravity sewer lines (6 inch and 8 inch only) and approximately 76 manholes. The project shall be completed fully within 45 working days (defined as Monday through Friday) after the award of the contract. The Contractor is responsible for providing any traffic control as may be necessary during working hours.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any one or all bids received. No bidder may withdraw a submitted Bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening of bids. The successful Bidder will be required to execute a Payment and a Performance Bond in the amount of One Hundred Percent (100%) of the Contract Price. Among other things, said Performance Bond shall provide that the Contractor will pay all subcontractors under him in said Contract.

Each Bidder is responsible for inspecting the sites and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the Contract Documents. By signing the Bid, the Bidder certifies that he has investigated the site conditions of the Project, fully satisfied himself of the conditions, and based his Bid accordingly. The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect to his Bid.

Liquidated Damages in the amount set out in the Specifications and Contract Documents will be assessed for failure to complete work within the Contract Completion Time as specified herein.

Contractor Requirements:

The Contractor (and/or subcontractor) shall be licensed for the classification of work required for the Project in accordance with Public Chapter No. 822 (House Bill No. 2180) "Contractors Licensing Act of 1976," passed March 18, 1976 by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, and any subsequent amendments thereto, or any Rules and Regulations promulgated by the State Board of Licensing Contractors and approved by proper legal authority. The entire wording of the Act shall be considered to be included by reference to these Contract Documents.

Indemnity and Insurance Requirements – It is specifically understood and agreed

between the parties that the Contractor shall indemnify City, defend and save it harmless against any and all claims, causes of action and/or suits which may be presented or brought, arising out of the conduct of the Contractor or any of its employees, servants or agents or subcontractors, in the performance of this agreement. In furtherance of this agreement for indemnity, but not by way of limitation thereof, Contractor shall obtain and keep in effect during the term hereof, and any extension, at his own expense, policies of insurance, indemnifying itself, and the City against all claims, causes of action and other liabilities or whatsoever kind and nature arising out of, or in any way connected with its activities pursuant to this contract, such insurance to cover:

- Workers Compensation benefits as required under the statutory limits for the State of Tennessee,
- General Liability to include damages for Bodily Injury, Property Damage, and Personal Injury in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence with a two million dollar (\$2,000,000) annual aggregate.
- Automobile Liability to include owned, hired, and non-owned motor vehicles in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence.

In addition to Insurance Certificates for the above coverages, an ENDORSEMENT NAMING THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS AN ADDITIONAL INSURED is required for the Liability and Automobile coverages.

On each envelope containing a Bid, the Bidder shall show name of project, his applicable State License Number, expiration date, and that part of the classification applying to the Bid; if applicable, the Electrical Contractors Name, State License Number, Expiration Date and Classification; otherwise, the Bid will not be opened.

Drug-Free Workplace Affidavits – T.C.A. §50-9-113. Effective January 2001, any contractor with five or more employees who provides construction services for the state or any local government is required to submit an affidavit stating that the contractor has a drug-free workplace program in compliance with the Tennessee Drug-Free Workplace Act, T.C.A. §50-9-101 through 50-0-113. *The Drug-Free workplace affidavit is to be submitted with the bid for this project.* This statute directs that no local government shall award any construction contract to a contractor who does not submit such an affidavit with its bid.

The Owner may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to perform the Work, and the Bidder shall furnish to the Owner all such information and data for this purpose as the Owner may request. The Owner reserves the right to reject any Bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such Bidder fails to satisfy the Owner that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Agreement and to complete the Work contemplated therein.
